RESOLUTION NO. R-1366-08

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO PLACE ON THE COMMISSION AGENDA WITHIN A SPECIFIED TIME PERIOD AN ORDINANCE WHICH COMPREHENSIVELY REVISES CHAPTER 31, ARTICLE III OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO PASSENGER MOTOR CARRIERS

WHEREAS, in Chapter 31 of the Code of Miami-Dade County (the “Code”), the County regulates vehicles for hire including, but not limited to, taxicabs, limousines and passenger motor carriers; and

WHEREAS, on July 9, 1998, the Commission adopted Ordinance No. 98-105 which comprehensively revised Miami-Dade County’s regulatory scheme for taxicabs; and

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2000, the County Commission approved Ordinance No. 00-139 which significantly revised the regulatory scheme for limousines; and

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County Consumer Services Department is currently reviewing Chapter 31, Article III of the Code that regulates passenger motor carriers with the intent of aligning the regulations with other Code provisions and bringing the regulations up to current standards; and

WHEREAS, the Commission believes that consideration of the Mayor’s proposed revisions of Chapter 31, Article III within the next one hundred and twenty (120) days is in the best interest of the citizens of Miami-Dade County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Mayor shall place on

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the Commission agenda within one hundred and twenty (120) days from the adoption of this resolution an ordinance which comprehensively revises Chapter 31, Article III of the Code.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairman Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Carlos A. Gimenez** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
