RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CO-DESIGNATION OF NW 22ND PLACE FROM NW 143RD STREET TO BURLINGTON STREET AS “SUSIE M. YOUNG PLACE” IN THE CITY OF OPA-LOCKA

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2008, the City Council of the City of Opa-Locka adopted Ordinance No. 08-18, which designated NW 22nd Place from NW 143rd Street to Burlington Street as “Susie M. Young Place” in recognition of her contributions to the City, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, NW 22nd Place from NW 143rd Street to Burlington Street is a city road located in the City of Opa-Locka; and

WHEREAS, the City of Opa-Locka wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 1,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the co-designation of NW 22nd Place from NW 143rd Street to Burlington Street in the City of Opa-Locka as “Susie M. Young Place”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the City Manager of the City of Opa-Locka, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the

Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan. It was offered by Commissioner **Jose "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 08-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OPA-LOCKA, FLORIDA APPROVING THE DUAL DESIGNATION OF NW 22ND PLACE AS "SUSIE M. YOUNG PLACE"; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in recognition of Susie M. Young's contributions to the City of Opa-locka ("City"), Commissioner Gail Miller proposed that NW 22nd Place be dual-designated as "Susie M. Young Place"; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 19, Article III, Sections 19-28 and 19-29 of the Opa-locka Code of Ordinances, the Beautification, Environmental Control and Streetnaming Board has reviewed the proposed street name change and made a recommendation to the City Commission of the City of Opa-locka ("City Commission"); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission provided notice of a public hearing to be held on 10/08/08 to consider the dual-designation of NW 22nd Place; and

WHEREAS, after hearing public comments on the matter, the City Commission has considered the recommendation to dual-designate NW 22nd Place as "Susie M. Young Place".

THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OPA-LOCKA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The recitals to the preamble herein are incorporated by reference.

Ordinance No. 08-18

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Opa-locka hereby approves the dual-designation of NW 22nd Place in the City of Opa-locka as "Susie M. Young Place" and directs the City Manager to take all necessary actions to carry-out the intent and objectives of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or Code provisions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall, upon adoption, become effective as specified by the City of Opa-locka Code of Ordinances and the City of Opa-locka Charter.


