RESOLUTION NO. R-245-09

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CO-DESIGNATION OF NW 22<sup>ND</sup> COURT FROM NW 143<sup>RD</sup> STREET TO BURLINGTON STREET IN THE CITY OF OPA-LOCKA AS “DORETHA J. PARKER COURT”

**WHEREAS**, on October 8, 2008, the City Council of the City of Opa-Locka adopted Ordinance No. 08-19, which co-designated NW 22<sup>nd</sup> Court from NW 143<sup>rd</sup> Street to Burlington Street as “Doretha J. Parker Court” in recognition of her contributions to the City, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, NW 22<sup>nd</sup> Court from NW 143<sup>rd</sup> Street to Burlington Street is a city road located in the City of Opa-Locka; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Opa-Locka wants the County to install signage indicating this co-designation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed co-designation is located in County Commission District 1,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the codesignation of NW 22<sup>nd</sup> Court from NW 143<sup>rd</sup> Street to Burlington Street in the City of Opa-Locka as “Doretha J. Parker Court” with this co-designation.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the City Manager of the City of Opa-Locka, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the

Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan. It was offered by Commissioner **Jose "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 08-19

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OPA-LOCKA, FLORIDA APPROVING THE DUAL DESIGNATION OF NW 22<sup>ND</sup> COURT AS "DORETHA J. PARKER COURT"; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, in recognition of Doretha J. Parker's contributions to the City of Opa-locka ("City"), Commissioner Gail Miller proposed that NW 22<sup>nd</sup> Court be dual-designated as "Doretha J Parker Court"; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Chapter 19, Article III, Sections 19-28 and 19-29 of the Opa-locka Code of Ordinances, the Beautification, Environmental Control and Streetnaming Board has reviewed the proposed street name change and made a recommendation to the City Commission of the City of Opa-locka ("City Commission"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission provided notice of a public hearing to be held on September 24, 2008 to consider the dual-designation of NW 22<sup>nd</sup> Court; and

**WHEREAS**, after hearing public comments on the matter, the City Commission has considered the recommendation to dual-designate NW 22<sup>nd</sup> Court as "Doretha J. Parker Court."

**THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OPA-LOCKA HEREBY ORDAINS:**

**Section 1.** The recitals to the preamble herein are incorporated by reference.

Ordinance No. 08-19

**Section 2.** The City Commission of the City of Opa-locka hereby dual-designates NW 22<sup>nd</sup> Court in the City of Opa-locka as "Doretha J. Parker Court" and directs the City Manager to take all necessary actions to carry-out the intent and objectives of this Ordinance.


**Section 3.** All ordinances or Code provisions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 4.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.


