

Subject: Contract Award Recommendation in the Amount of \$577,500.00 Between Kailas Corp. and Miami-Dade County for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) Project Entitled Intersection Improvement Contract (Project – CICC 7040-0/07 Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) No. 20080210)

Recommendation

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the Intersection Improvement Contract (Project – CICC 7040-0/07 RPQ No. 20080210), in the amount of \$577,500.00, between Kailas Corp. and Miami-Dade County has been prepared by the Public Works Department (PWD) and is recommended for approval. Proceeds from the Charter County Transit System Sales Surtax (the Surtax) will be used to fund this project, therefore, approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) and Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) is required.

Scope

The work to be performed under the life of this contract includes intersection improvements at various locations within Miami-Dade County.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$577,500.00 and will be funded from the Surtax. The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. Specific funding for this project will be allocated from the respective Commission District PTP yearly allocations. The base contract amount is \$500,000.00, but the total allocated amount is \$577,500.00, which is inclusive of the contingency and dedicated allowances.

Delegation of Authority

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this contract.

Track Record/Monitor

The contractor, Kailas Corp., is currently performing work for PWD at a satisfactory level as reported by the Project Manager. PWD has reviewed the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) database and found 21 awarded construction contracts for Kailas Corp. and are listed as follows: two (2) contracts from each of the following Departments: Seaport Department (SP), the Department of Environmental Resources Management (DERM), and the Fire Department (FR); ten (10) from the Parks and Recreation Department (PRD), one (1) from the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CR) and four (4) from PWD. The referenced database also lists a total of 15 contractor performance evaluations with an overall performance rating of satisfactory performance (3.7), out of a possible superior performance (4.0) rating. In addition, the Department of Small Business Development's (SBD) History of Violation's report lists no violation for this contractor.

Following PWD's standard operating procedures, after award of this contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. Throughout all PTP projects, the responsible staff person in PWD will be the PTP Coordinator, Mr. Frank Aira, P.E. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Joaquin Rabassa, P.E., Project Coordinator, for day to day responsibilities.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, Kailas Corp., Company Principal is: Jorge Paz and the Company's address is listed as: 12101 NW 98 Avenue, Bay 6, Hialeah Gardens, Florida 33018.

Background

In an effort to accelerate the continued success of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWD is taking advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the subject Miscellaneous Construction Contracting process available under OCI contract CICC 7040-0/07. Through this process, PWD forwards the RPQ, by way of facsimile transmission, to a pool of pre-qualified Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) contractors for the subject trade. Additionally, PWD advertises the project in the Daily Business Review and all solicitations are available on-line through the Miami-Dade County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. Interested contractors prepare their bids according to the Job Order Contracting (JOC) process, whereby the County establishes unit prices for the pay items in accordance with industry averages. The contractors submit their bid as an overall percentage factor of the pricing established by the County. The project award evaluation is based upon the lowest percentage submitted by the responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWD staff determined that the scope of work for this project qualified for a CSBE set-aside (Levels I, II, and III) designation. Therefore, on November 26, 2008, PWD forwarded an RPQ for the Intersection Improvement Contract, utilizing the OCI contract CICC 7040-0/07, to a list of 44 pre-qualified firms. Six (6) firms purchased contract documents and three (3) firms proffered a bid. Kailas Corp. proffered the lowest responsive, responsible base bid of 1.08 percentage factor, 8% over the County's cost estimate; the second lowest bidder, Leyram Construction, Inc., proffered a base bid of 1.09, 1% over the lowest bidder; the third lowest bidder, JVA Engineering Contractor, Inc., proffered a base bid of 1.17, 8% over the second lowest bidder. As a result, on January 16, 2009, PWD issued a recommendation of award for RPQ 20080210 to Kailas Corp., with the stipulation that approval of this project must be obtained from the BCC and the CITT due to guidelines associated with the funding source.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, equipment and tools to perform all operations necessary for intersection improvements. This work includes construction of asphaltic concrete road base and surface, pavement removal, pavement milling and markings, signage, drainage, sidewalks, concrete curb and gutters and traffic calming devices.




