RESOLUTION NO. **R-110-09** _____

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING S.W. 18TH STREET
BETWEEN 137th AVENUE AND 142nd AVENUE AS “ELYSA
K. MESTRIL STREET”

WHEREAS, Elysa K. Mestril was born on Father’s Day, June 18, 1980 at Baptist Hospital in Miami; and

WHEREAS, while growing up, Mestril enjoyed playing basketball, both at St. Agatha Elementary School and Saint Brendan High School; and

WHEREAS, Mestril graduated from Saint Brendan in 2008, with honors in science and arts; and

WHEREAS, Mestril had been accepted to Florida International University School of Medicine and was planning to begin classes during the 2008 summer semester; and

WHEREAS, Mestril would have been the first member of her family to attend college; and

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2008 -- five days short of her 18th birthday -- Mestril’s life was tragically taken in an automobile accident; and

WHEREAS, Mestril was a source of inspiration, strength and confidence to those around her; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Elysa K. Mestril by codesignating the location of her tragic and untimely death, S.W. 18th Street between 137th Avenue and 142nd Avenue, as “Elysa K. Mestril Street”; and

WHEREAS, S.W. 18th Street between 137th Avenue and 142nd Avenue is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 11,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Codesignates S.W. 18th Street between 137th Avenue and 142nd Avenue as “Elysa K. Mestril Street.”

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Jose “Pepe” Diaz** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
