

RESOLUTION NO. R-373-09

RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DESIGNATION OF THE LUDWIG VAN BEETHOVEN PROMENADE UNDER THE METRORAIL GUIDEWAY FROM SW 8TH STREET TO THE BRICKELL METRORAIL STATION ENTRANCE TO INCLUDE TWO ADDITIONAL BLOCKS TO THE NORTH ALONG THE EXISTING PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE M-PATH (PEDESTRIAN GREENWAY) TO THE MIAMI RIVER'S SHORELINE

WHEREAS, Ludwig van Beethoven was and remains one of the world's greatest composers; and

WHEREAS, despite discovering that he was suffering from a severe hearing impairment, Beethoven succeeded in composing some of the greatest musical compositions of all times including the famed 9th Symphony; and

WHEREAS, nearly all subsequent developments in the "classical" genre owe something to Beethoven's musical genius; and

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2002, the City of Miami officially designated SW 9th Street as Beethoven 9th Symphony Street; and

WHEREAS, to promote cultural awareness, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 463-03 on May 6, 2003 designating the area under the Metrorail Guideway from S.W. 8th Street to the Metrorail Brickell Station entrance as the Ludwig van Beethoven Promenade; and

WHEREAS, the Miami River Commission has unanimously recommended that the Beethoven Promenade be extended two additional blocks from S.W. 8th Street to the Miami River's south shoreline; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Miami-Dade County to promote and celebrate the valuable musical accomplishments of Ludwig van Beethoven by extending the Beethoven Promenade to the Miami River along the M-Path, which is a pedestrian greenway beneath the Metrorail Guideway,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby extends the designation of the Ludwig van Beethoven Promenade, which currently includes the area under the Metrorail Guideway from S.W. 8th Street to the Brickell Metrorail Station, to include two additional blocks to the north of Southwest 8th Street along the existing publicly accessible M-Path to the Miami River's south shoreline.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Jose "Pepe" Diaz** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
