**RESOLUTION NO. R-547-09**

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE STATE ROAD DESIGNATION OF S.W./N.W. 12<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE BETWEEN S.W. 8<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND N.W. 64<sup>TH</sup> STREET AS "KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE AVENUE"

**WHEREAS**, during the 2008 regular session, the Florida Legislature passed Senate Bill 1604, which, among other state road designations, designated that portion of S.W./N.W. 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue between S.W. 8<sup>th</sup> Street and N.W. 64<sup>th</sup> Street as "Katherine Fernandez Rundle Avenue"; and

**WHEREAS**, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the installation of road designation signs shall be contingent on the applicable county or city commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary road designation,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the state road designation of that portion of S.W./N.W. 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue between S.W. 8<sup>th</sup> Street and N.W. 64<sup>th</sup> Street as "Katherine Fernandez Rundle Avenue."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation.
