RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE FEBRUARY 7, 2009 "PUBLIC SAFETY DAY" EVENT SPONSORED BY THE VILLAGE OF KEY BISCAZYNE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,166.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 7 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Village of Key Biscayne, has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the February 7, 2009 "Public Safety Day" event in an amount not to exceed \$2,166.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Services Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the "Public Safety Day" event is to raise community awareness about the importance of fire safety and law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the "Public Safety Day" is a small event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Services Application, and \$2,166.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the District 7 In-kind Reserve Fund,

Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services is being requested by the Village of Key Biscayne for their "Public Safety Day" event held on February 7, 2009.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$2,166 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the use of a large show mobile. This event will be funded from District 7 in-kind reserve fund.
