

Subject: Resolution Authorizing Miami-Dade County Corrections to Establish a Deposit Only
Account Associated with the Alternative Incarceration Trust Account

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve the attached resolution in order to establish a Deposit Only Account with Wachovia Bank in Miami, Florida.

Scope

This resolution only impacts the Miami-Dade Corrections and Rehabilitation Department.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

This resolution does not have any fiscal impact to the department.

Track Record/Monitor

This account will be monitored by the Miami-Dade Corrections and Rehabilitation Department (MDCR) Commander, Maxine Harris of the Budget and Finance Bureau.

Background

MDCR is responsible for the supervision of inmates who have been permitted by the judge presiding over their criminal case to participate in Alternative Incarceration programs such as the House Arrest Program, Boot Camp Program and Weekender Program. Currently, program participation fees are received by MDCR staff from program participants and are subsequently deposited in the Miami-Dade County Alternative Incarceration Trust Account at Wachovia Bank in Miami, Florida. These fees help defray the MDCR costs of administering the respective programs and may include percentages of their income, flat fees and can ultimately be waived by a judge for those participants that can not pay or have lost their job. This item modifies the collection process to require program participants or their families to go to any Wachovia Bank branch to deposit the participation fees into the newly established deposit only account themselves.

Deposits will be made directly to the deposit only account and then automatically transferred to the MDCR Alternative Incarceration Trust Account each business day in order to avoid any opportunity for inappropriate actions by program participants. Thus, the deposit only account will maintain a zero balance. MDCR staff consulted with bank representatives and the Finance Department and it was recommended that MDCR establish this new zero balance deposit only account.

The Alternative Incarceration Trust Account is used by MDCR to pay vendor charges for monitoring equipment, to refund supervision fees pursuant to court order, and to transfer funds to revenue accounts. The implementation of this program will enhance internal controls.

RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A DEPOSIT ONLY
ACCOUNT IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE MIAMI-
DADE COUNTY CORRECTIONS ALTERNATIVE
INCARCERATION TRUST ACCOUNT

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, the Board hereby authorizes a Deposit Only Account be established, in association with the Miami-Dade County Corrections Alternative Incarceration Trust Account at the Wachovia Bank in Miami, Florida, for the purpose of collecting supervision fees from participants of alternative to incarceration programs.
