RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR NOTIFICATION OF ROAD AND PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the necessary construction of roads and other infrastructure projects may cause significant disturbances to residential and commercial properties during the period of construction; and

WHEREAS, the impact of such conditions may in certain instances be reduced by advance notification of such projects to the affected property owners; and

WHEREAS Miami-Dade County wishes to advance construction projects and thereby promote jobs and the well being of our community in a responsible manner and with the least adverse impact to the neighbors immediately surrounding such projects,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The County Mayor or his designee is hereby directed to notify any and all occupants of residential or commercial structures directly adjacent to the site of construction of a road or other public infrastructure project not later than thirty (30) days in advance of the notice to proceed for the project.

Section 2. The County Mayor or his designee is also directed to notify the Commission office representing the district where the construction or public infrastructure project will take place.

Section 3. The notice shall be in writing and delivered through any reasonable mean which may include, but is not limited to, posting and hand-delivery. The notice shall contain at a

minimum an indication of the anticipated date of commencement of the project, the expected duration and, in the event that the project involves the temporary closing of a road or sidewalk or a portion of road or sidewalk, the anticipated period of such closure.
