RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE FEBRUARY 21, 2009 "MARDI GRAS 2009" CELEBRATION SPONSORED BY THE HOMESTEAD MERCHANTS ASSOCIATION, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,395.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 9 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Homestead Merchants Association, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the February 21, 2009 "Mardi Gras 2009" in an amount not to exceed \$1,395.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the "Mardi Gras 2009" event is a traditional festival which will showcase the historical district of Homestead, and raise funds for both Habitat for Humanity of Greater Miami and the Homestead Merchants Association; and

WHEREAS, Homestead Merchants Association, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the "Mardi Gras 2009" is a district event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$1,395.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the District 9 In-kind Reserve Fund,

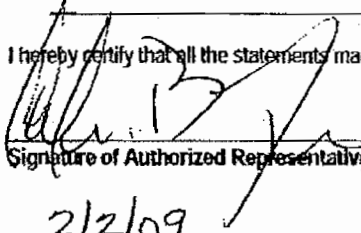

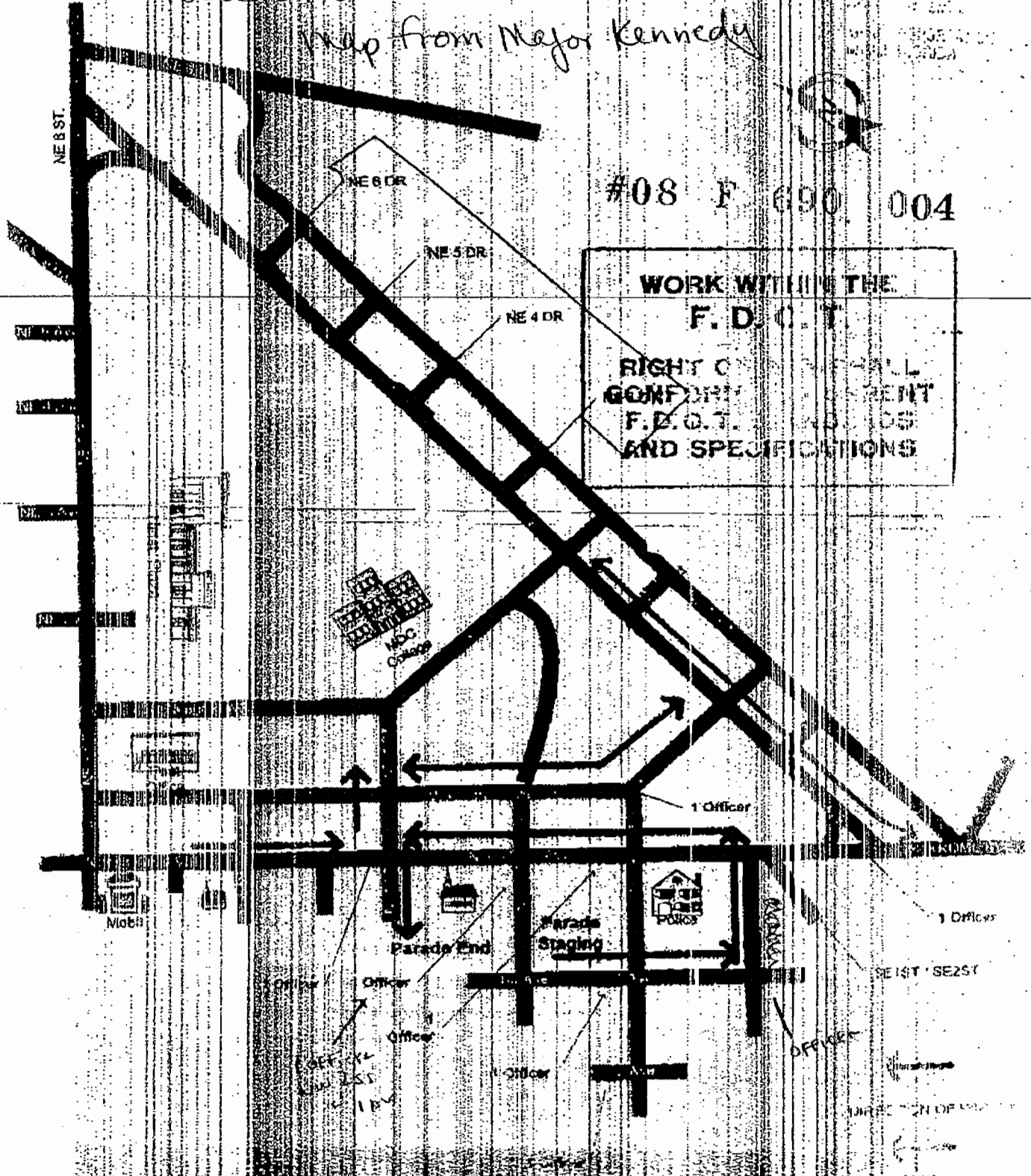

Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for this item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization, the Homestead Merchants Association, Inc. for their "Mardi Gras 2009" event held on February 21, 2009.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$1,395 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the use of a small show mobile. This event will be funded from the District 9 in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2008-09, Homestead Merchants Association, Inc. has received \$5,000 from District 9 discretionary reserve.
