Resolution Ratifying the County Mayor's or County Mayor's Designee Action in Authorizing Capital Improvement Contracts Pursuant to Section 2-8.2.7 of the

Code of Miami-Dade County relating to the Economic Stimulus Plan

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners adopt the attached resolution ratifying the County Mayor's or County Mayor's designee actions taken from November 13, 2008 through March 20, 2009 in expediting the capital improvement projects identified on the attached schedule (Exhibit "A") as authorized by Ordinance No. 08-92 creating the "Economic Stimulus Plan" (ESP). During this period, five projects in the amount of \$7,769,972.38 were awarded:

- PB Americas, Inc. in the amount of \$1,212,160.00 for the Seaport Department
- Master Excavators, Inc. in the amount of \$1,073,459.86 for the Public Works Department (PWD)
- Two awards to Trans Florida Development Corp. in the amounts of \$1,385,036.73 and \$1,337,557.07 for the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD), and
- Quality Paving Corp. in the amount of \$2,761,758.72 for PWD.

#### SCOPE

The five contract awards detailed in Exhibit "A" involve providing engineering and construction services for capital improvement projects that are located within Commission Districts 5, 8 and 11. However, the Seaport project will have countywide impact.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

The contracts are funded by a variety of funding sources, as described in the proposed capital plan for FY 2008-09 for the specific project being awarded with the five projects totaling \$7,769,972.38.

#### TRACK RECORD / MONITOR

The contractors on the attached Exhibit "A" have received previous contracts from the County and performed or are performing work for various County departments. PB Americas, Inc. shows 10 performance evaluations in the Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) reflecting satisfactory performance. Trans Florida Development Corp. shows one performance evaluation in CIIS reflecting satisfactory performance. Quality Paving Corp. has 22 performance evaluations in CIIS with an overall guarded performance rating. Master Excavators, Inc. has not performed any work for the County since 2000; therefore the CIIS database has no records for this firm.

The staff assigned to the day-to-day operations of these contracts is listed in the contract award memorandum for the project. The ESP is being coordinated and monitored by the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) Director, Johnny Martinez, P.E.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Section 2-8.2.7 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, known as the "Economic Stimulus Plan" (ESP), adopted by the Board on July 17, 2008 through Ordinance 08-92, provides for expeditious treatment of professional service agreements and construction contracts associated with funded capital improvement projects identified in the approved annual capital budget (Proposed Capital Budget and Multi-Year Capital Plan) and included by the Board via Resolution No. R-851-08 or subsequently added by the Board via resolution.

The ESP is an effective way to stimulate the local economy and accelerate the County's capital program by moving funded projects through the contracting process at a quicker pace thereby providing an opportunity for our government to lesson the negative impact of the current economic conditions on the building professions and trades. The ESP reduces the timeline, about 90-120 days on each procurement cycle, to advertise solicitations and competitive bids and award qualifying projects, design and construction contracts, resulting in significant efficiencies in the implementation of those projects.

During this reporting period, OCI processed the five qualifying awards as listed in Exhibit "A." Exhibit "A" also includes a summary of the Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE), Community Business Enterprise (CBE), Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) and Community Workforce Program (CWF) participation for ESP projects.

The Department of Small Business Development (SBD) is supporting the ESP by accelerating the project review and goal analysis process to ensure participation of small businesses on County contracts. All ESP projects are reviewed by SBD for the application of program measures in the areas of construction, architecture and engineering services. Between November 13, 2008 and March 20, 2009, SBD reviewed 13 projects under the ESP. Small business programs measures approved during this period for small business participation totaled \$7,257,253 or 14.7 percent, representing a 4.7 percent increase over the 10 percent six month average prior to the approval of the stimulus plan. The average turnaround time for expedited project review and goal analysis during this period was two days, representing a five day decrease in the average processing time.

In total, eight projects have been awarded under the authority granted through Ordinance No. 08-92. However, there are other projects that are part of the Plan which have been expedited utilizing alternative contracting mechanisms. Alternative contracting mechanisms include contracts advertised, awarded or underway using the Miscellaneous Construction Contract (MCC) 7040, Department of Procurement Management and other existing departmental contracts, in-house forces and grant agreements. To date, ESP projects implemented using alternative contracting mechanisms is \$151.4 million as detailed on Exhibit "B."
