

RESOLUTION NO. R-455-09

RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING SW 122 AVENUE FROM SW 232 STREET TO SW 236 STREET AS "JOSEPH ALLEN FIELDER AVENUE"

WHEREAS, Joseph Allen Fielder was born in Webster County, Nebraska, on July 9, 1947; and

WHEREAS, Fielder served in Vietnam where he earned the ranks of Staff Sergeant and Chief Warrant Officer 3; and

WHEREAS, Fielder received many decorations, among them the Army Service Ribbon, NCO Professional Development Ribbon, Good Conduct Medal, Army Commendation Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Overseas Service Ribbon, Overseas Bar, Senior Army Aviator Badge, Export Badge M-16, Rifle Badge and SBC Stripes; and

WHEREAS, Fielder served his final years of service as Chief of Base Operations at Homestead Air Reserve Base; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Allen Fielder passed away March 22, 2007, predeceased by his first wife, Penny, and survived by his widow Kim, 12 children and 11 grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Joseph Allen Fielder by codesignating SW 122 Avenue from SW 232 Street to SW 236 Street as "Joseph Allen Fielder Avenue"; and

WHEREAS, SW 122 Avenue from SW 232 Street to SW 236 Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 8,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, co-designates SW 122 Avenue from SW 232 Street to SW 236 Street as Joseph Allen Fielder Avenue.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Katy Sorenson. It was offered by Commissioner **Katy Sorenson** who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Dorrin D. Rolle** , and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
