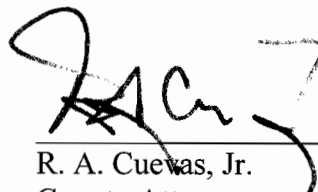

RESOLUTION NO. R-594-09

RESOLUTION URGING SOUTH FLORIDA WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD TO ENTER INTO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO PROVIDE PRIMARY FIRST-STOP FUNCTION FOR WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATIONS AND WORKFORCE RECRUITMENT/REFERRAL ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE COUNTY'S COMMUNITY WORKFORCE PROGRAM AND INCLUDING COORDINATED PARTICIPATION IN JOB CLEARING HOUSE

WHEREAS, the South Florida Workforce Investment Board (SFWIB) provides workforce development services in Region 23 of the State of Florida (Miami-Dade and Monroe Counties); and

WHEREAS, SFWIB services and resources are available through a workforce delivery system consisting of Career Centers located throughout Region 23; and

WHEREAS, the SFWIB's delivery of services is enhanced through the integration of available resources, coordination of services through effective, linkages and partnerships and the sharing of information and referrals that may lead to successful employment and self-sufficiency for customers; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County's Department of Small Business Development ("SBD") administers the Community Workforce Program ("CWP") requiring application of local workforce goals on certain capital construction contracts for public improvements located in Designated Target Areas ("DTAs") to seek to ensure a minimum of 10% of the persons performing the construction trades and labor work under the contract are residents of DTAs; and

WHEREAS, the SBD utilizes the services of Workforce Development Organizations (“WDOs”) and Workforce Recruitment/Referral Organizations (“WROs”) to accomplish the CWP objective of establishing a pool of trained skilled and unskilled labor to meet industry demand; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County’s Job Clearinghouse is designed to inform the community of certain specified employment opportunities and is administered by SBD,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby urges the South Florida Workforce Investment Board to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Miami-Dade County to provide primary first-stop functions for Workforce Development Organizations and Workforce Recruitment/Referral Organizations for Miami-Dade County’s Community Workforce Program including coordinated participation in the County’s Job Clearinghouse administered by SBD.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dorrin D. Rolle. It was offered by Commissioner **Jose “Pepe” Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Carlos A. Gimenez** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
