**Subject:** Approval of the Use of Charter County Transit System Surtax Funds for the Purchase of Goods and Services

**Resolution No. R-509-09**

**This package, listed as Agenda Item 3B on the April 15, 2009 Transit, Infrastructure and Roads Committee meeting agenda, was amended to correct the total contract amount to \$7,033,000 instead of \$7,698,000 for Item No. 1, in Table 1.**

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve the use of Charter County Transit System Surtax (Surtax) funds for the contracts listed in **Table 1** and **Table 2** for goods and services supporting the People's Transportation Plan (PTP). The allocation represents the maximum anticipated spending out of the MDT Operating budget and does not guarantee that the entire allocation will be expended by Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) or the Public Works Department (PWD).

### **Scope**

These contracts support MDT services on a countywide basis, and specific PWD projects in accordance with Exhibit 1 of the PTP, and its amendments.

### **Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

The MDT allocation is listed in **Table 1** under "Contract Amount" at \$1,000,000. The attached goods and services will support operations associated with the implementation of capital improvements, maintenance, and/or operations and will be funded out of the MDT Operating budget. Other funding sources such as state or federal funding will be utilized, as appropriate. Funding will be expended only if the MDT budget can support the expenditures based on the approved Resource Allocation Plan adopted annually by the Board.


The fiscal impact for the PWD contract is also listed in **Table 2** under Contract Amount and is estimated at approximately \$200,000. The single contract listed, Specialized Tree-Trimming Services, is necessary in order to carry out the Public Works projects included in Exhibit 1 of the PTP Ordinance under Neighborhood Improvements and Major Highway and Road Improvements.

### **Track Record/Monitor**

Fred Shields, Chief, MDT Materials Management and Frank Aira, P.E., CFM Manager, PWD will monitor these contracts. In addition to MDT staff, the Office of the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust monitors the use of Surtax funds in conjunction with the CITT.

### **Background**

The contract being presented to the Board, and included on the attached **Table 1** and **Table 2** may require the use of Surtax funds. Details are provided in the attached.



During the term of this contract, MDT anticipates expending up to \$300,000 in MDT operating revenue, state and/or federal grants.

It would cost them more to incorporate these services into an actual roadway construction as the PTP contract is not for landscaping but for actual construction work.</p>
