RESOLUTION WAIVING PURCHASING REQUIREMENTS
OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 3-38 FOR PURCHASES OF
GOODS AND SERVICES FOR HOSTING THE 5TH JOE A.
MARTINEZ HEALTH AND SAFETY EXPO, JUNE 27, 2009

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 3-38 was established pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County to establish processes and procedures for County purchases of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, the 5th Joe A. Martinez Health & Safety Expo is currently scheduled for June 27, 2009 and is a free event for people of all ages and areas of Miami-Dade County to educate them on personal wellness for healthier living; and

WHEREAS, the Office of County Commissioner Joe A. Martinez, District 11, of the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners, will host the 5th Joe A. Martinez Health & Safety Expo on June 27, 2009 and must secure the purchase of goods and services to do so; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of goods and services to host the 5th Joe A. Martinez Health & Safety Expo on June 27, 2009 are below the threshold amount requiring formal sealed bids set forth Section 2-8.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the requirements of Administrative Order 3-38 and any applicable Miami-Dade County Department of Procurement Guidelines are waived for the purchases of goods and services to host the 5th Joe A.
