RESOLUTION NO. R-732-09

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR THE MAYOR'S  
DESIGNEE TO PREPARE A REPORT TO THE BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WITH PROPOSED USES OF  
ROUND 2 OF NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION  
PROGRAM FUNDS

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County, like much of the nation, is experiencing a period of economic hardship; and

**WHEREAS**, the federal government is attempting to address the economic hardship facing communities by making a second round of Neighborhood Stabilization Program funds (NSP II) available to local communities; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County anticipates receiving a portion of these NSP II funds; and

**WHEREAS**, as with the original NSP funds, it is anticipated that there will be a requirement to commit and expend the funds expeditiously; and

**WHEREAS**, in order for the County to expend the funds timely and effectively, the County should have a list of projects and opportunities outlined and ready for implementation,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board does hereby Direct the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to prepare a report with proposed uses of Round 2 of Neighborhood Stabilization Program funds. The report shall at a minimum outline creative ways to utilize NSP II funds in connection with municipalities, non-profits, and for profit entities and shall include a list of opportunities and projects for funding. Projects to be considered for funding shall, amongst other projects, include the Landmark project located on NW 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue

and 199<sup>th</sup> Street and the North Dade Cultural Arts Center. In considering projects for funding, special consideration should be given to making projects green by taking advantage of green technologies and green solutions. The Mayor shall bring the report to the Board of County Commissioners within thirty days from the passage of this resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan. It was offered by Commissioner **Jose "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
