RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE JUNE 19 THROUGH AUGUST 14, 2009 "SUMMER CAMP FIELD TRIPS" SPONSORED BY THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$970.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 6 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami, has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the June 19-August 14, 2009 "Summer Camp Field Trips" in an amount not to exceed \$970.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the "Summer Camp Field Trips" will include five supervised field trips for children to Crandon Park beach; and

WHEREAS, each field trip will involve approximately 100 children and will include lunch; and

WHEREAS, the "Summer Camp Field Trips" is a district event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$970.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the District 6 In-kind Reserve Fund,





Important Information for Exempt Organizations

Your *Consumer's Certificate of Exemption* is to be used solely by your organization for your organization's customary nonprofit activities.

Purchases made by an individual on behalf of the organization are taxable, even if the individual will be reimbursed by the organization.

This exemption applies only to purchases your organization makes. The sale or lease to others by your organization of tangible personal property, sleeping accommodations or other real property is taxable. Your organization must register, and collect and remit sales and use tax on such taxable transactions. Note: Churches are exempt from this requirement except when they are the lessor of real property (Rule 12A-1.070, FAC).

It is a criminal offense to fraudulently present this certificate to evade the payment of sales tax. Under no circumstances should this certificate be used for the personal benefit of any individual. Violators will be liable for payment of the sales tax plus a penalty of 200% of the tax, and may be subject to conviction of a third degree felony. Any violation will necessitate the revocation of this certificate.

Subject: District Specific In-Kind Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends this item move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by the City of West Miami, for their "Summer Camp Field Trips" scheduled for June 19-August 14, 2009.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$970 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for a waiver of entry and pavilion rental fees at Crandon Park. This event will be funded from the District 6 in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2008-09, the City of West Miami received \$2,000 from the District 6 county services reserve.
