RESOLUTION NO. R-866-09

RESOLUTION URGING THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO SUPPORT THE "SAVING PEDESTRIANS EVERYWHERE EVERY DAY" ("S.P.E.E.D.") INITIATIVE AND TO EXPAND THIS MODEL PROGRAM TO MORE SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the safety of children near school zones is an issue of paramount importance to the citizens of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the Miami Lakes Middle School Project Citizen Class developed and implemented the Saving Pedestrians Everywhere Every Day ("S.P.E.E.D.") Initiative to educate students and the public at large on the safety issues of children near school zones, to seek input from the community, and to advocate for legislative changes before the Florida Legislature in order to provide additional safety measures; and

WHEREAS, the S.P.E.E.D. Initiative increases community awareness on the issue of school zone safety; and

WHEREAS, the S.P.E.E.D. Initiative conducts valuable research including neighborhood surveys in order to develop legislative solutions to combat school zone speeding; and

WHEREAS, expanding the S.P.E.E.D. Initiative to other schools throughout the district will increase community awareness and education regarding the danger of speeding in school zones as well as provide a hands-on community forum to advocate for legislative changes designed to protect children in school zones,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Hereby urges the School Board of Miami-Dade County to support the S.P.E.E.D. Initiative and expand the Initiative to additional schools throughout the district in order to increase awareness of the problem of school zone speeding and to involve children and neighborhoods across the entire Miami-Dade County School District in creating and advocating solutions.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this resolution to the Chair and Members of the School Board of Miami-Dade County.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Natacha Seijas. It was offered by Commissioner **Jose "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption.
