

RESOLUTION NO. R-903-09

**RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-336-09 RELATED TO MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA SUBORDINATE SPECIAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO INCREASE MAXIMUM TRUE INTEREST COST RATE; AND PROVIDING SEVERABILITY**

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County, Florida (the “County”) pursuant to Section 208 of Ordinance No. 97-210 enacted by the Board of County Commissioners of Miami-Dade County, Florida (the “Board”) on November 18, 1997, as amended by Ordinance No. 05-99 enacted by the Board on May 17, 2005 (collectively, the “1997 Ordinance”), Ordinance No. 09-22 (the “Series 2009 Ordinance”) and Resolution No. R-336-09 adopted by the Board on April 7, 2009 (the “Series 2009 Resolution” and together with the 1997 Ordinance and the Series 2009 Ordinance, the “Bond Ordinance”), is authorized to issue the Series 2009 Bonds in one or more series, in an aggregate original principal amount not to exceed \$130,000,000; and

**WHEREAS**, all capitalized terms used in this resolution which are not defined shall have the meaning assigned to such terms in the Bond Ordinance unless otherwise expressly provided or the context otherwise clearly requires; and

**WHEREAS**, the County’s Professional Sports Franchise Facilities Tax Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2009A, and the Professional Sports Franchise Facilities Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2009C, (collectively, the “PST Tax-Exempt Bonds”) are being sold on or about the same date as the Series 2009 Bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that the Series 2009 Bonds will only be issued as Tax-Exempt Bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to amend the Series 2009 Resolution to increase the Maximum TIC on the Tax-Exempt Bonds to 8.20%; provided, however, that the Maximum TIC on the Tax-Exempt Bonds, when blended with the true interest cost rate on the PST Tax-Exempt Bonds, shall not exceed 7.50%,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated in this resolution and are approved.

Section 2. The Series 2009 Resolution is hereby amended to provide that the Maximum TIC on the Tax-Exempt Bonds is increased from 7.50% to 8.20%; provided, however, that the Maximum TIC on the Tax-Exempt Bonds, when blended with the true interest cost rate on the PST Tax-Exempt Bonds, shall not exceed 7.50%.

Section 3. In case any one or more of the provisions of this resolution shall for any reason be held to be illegal or invalid, such illegality or invalidity shall not affect any other provisions of this resolution and such other provisions shall be construed and enforced as if such illegal or invalid provision had not been contained in this resolution. All or any part of any resolutions or proceedings in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are to the extent of such conflict repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency; provided, however, that to the extent not amended hereby, the Series 2009 Resolution is hereby ratified and confirmed.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


