RESOLUTION NO. R-1079-09

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-541-09 TO ELIMINATE THE PREVIOUSLY-ESTABLISHED CAP ON THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF FUNDING THAT ANY ONE COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATION MAY REQUEST IN RESPONSE TO THE 2009-2010 HUMAN AND SOCIAL SERVICES COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS FUNDING REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (“RFP”); AND REINFORCING THAT REGARDLESS OF THE REQUEST, NO SINGLE COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATION WILL RECEIVE MORE THAN ONE MILLION DOLLARS IN FUNDING THROUGH THIS RFP PROCESS

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2009 this Board adopted Resolution No. R-541-09, which approved the Human and Social Services Community-based Organization Funding and Request for Proposals (“RFP”) process, service priority areas, and percentage allocations for funding commencing in FY 2009-2019; and

WHEREAS, one of the competitive solicitation process criteria delineated in Attachment A, Section 12 of the previously adopted Resolution instituted a cap on the maximum amount of funding that any one community-based organization may request from the RFP at no more than \$1,000,000; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the RFP process to not place a limit on the amounts that community-based organizations may request in response to the RFP; and

WHEREAS, although there is no limit to how much any given community-based organization may request through the RFP process, no single community-based organization will be awarded more than \$1,000,000,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby amends Resolution No. R-541-09 to eliminate the previously-established cap on the maximum

amount of funding that any one community-based organization may request in response to the 2009-2010 Human and Social Services Community-based Organizations Funding and Request for Proposals; and reinforces that despite the elimination of this cap, no single community-based organization will be awarded more than \$1,000,000 through this RFP process.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Natacha Seijas and the Co-Sponsor is Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner **Natacha Seijas**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Barbara J. Jordan** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
