

RESOLUTION NAMING THE MIAMI-DADE TRANSIT
METROMOVER MAINTENANCE FACILITY AFTER
JOSEPH BRYANT

WHEREAS, Joseph Bryant was a dedicated Miami-Dade Transit employee for 28 years; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Bryant spent fifteen years in the Metromover Maintenance Division, rising to the rank of Metromover Maintenance Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Bryant was an exemplary County employee, as evidenced by his multiple awards, including employee of the month and the coveted Miami-Dade Transit Employee of the Quarter; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Bryant tragically lost his life while on duty on the evening of June 19, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Metromover Maintenance Facility is located at 100 S.W. 1st Avenue, within County Commission District 5,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby approves the naming of the Metromover Maintenance Facility at 100 S.W. 1st Avenue as the "Joseph Bryant Metromover Maintenance Facility."

Summary

This resolution modifies the current designation¹ of the Metromover Maintenance Facility located at 100 S.W. 1 Avenue to Joseph Bryant Metromover Maintenance Facility. On June 19, 2009, Joseph Bryant, a Metromover Maintenance Facility Supervisor, was killed in the line of work.

Background and Relevant Legislation

According to Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) staff, there are three (3) MDT facilities currently named for national/local people: Central-Rosa Parks Central Transportation Building; Central- Sheila Winitzer Central Administration Building; and the Northeast-Claude Rolfe Northeast Bus Facility.

The approximate cost of renaming the Metromover Maintenance Facility is \$15,000 (inclusive of signage and the placement of a plaque). The timeframe for renaming the facility may take two (2) months.

The 33,500-square foot Metromover Maintenance building was dedicated on May 29, 1984.
