WHEREAS, on April 7, 2009, this Board passed Resolution No. 378-09, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference, directing the Mayor or Designee to work with the Foundation For Democracy In Africa (FDA), Beacon Council, Defense Alliance, Homestead Air Reserve Base, SOUTHCOM, and other applicable entities to bring AFRICOM to Homestead Air Reserve Base or some other suitable site in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, lobbying efforts before the federal executive and legislative branches may assist in bringing AFRICOM to Homestead Air Reserve Base,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges Congress and the U.S. Department of Defense to locate the U.S. Africa Command (AFRICOM) at Homestead Air Reserve Base or some other suitable site in Miami-Dade County.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the members of the Miami-Dade Congressional Delegation, the U.S. Secretary of Defense and the Commander of the U.S. Africa Command.

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO WORK WITH THE FOUNDATION FOR DEMOCRACY IN AFRICA (FDA), BEACON COUNCIL, DEFENSE ALLIANCE, HOMESTEAD AIR RESERVE BASE (HARB), SOUTHCOM, AND OTHER APPROPRIATE GROUPS IN BRINGING AFRICOM TO HARB

WHEREAS, the decision to create the United States-Africa Command (AFRICOM) was due in part to Africa's increasing strategic importance to the United States (U.S.); and

WHEREAS, the establishment of AFRICOM in Miami-Dade County will assist in achieving the goal of positioning Florida as the gateway to Africa as envisioned at the AfrICANDO Trade and Investment Conference in 1998. AfrICANDO 1998, a program initiated by the Foundation for Democracy in Africa (FDA), was born of the idea that Florida with its physical proximity to Africa and its solid infrastructure, makes the region ideal for moving people, products and services from the U.S. and other Western Hemisphere countries to Africa and facilitating goods, services, and people coming from Africa to the U.S. and other nations of the Western Hemisphere; and

WHEREAS, the economic benefit of Miami-Dade County serving as the gateway to Africa is enormous and will assist in enhancing the economic, social and cultural quality of life in the region, creating jobs and attracting more companies and institutions to Florida to take advantage of the increased U.S.-Africa trade and investment activities; and

WHEREAS, AFRICOM's presence in Miami-Dade County, specifically its relocation to HARB, will create jobs and expand economic activities as well as enhance South Florida's chances of success as a gateway to Africa,
