Subject: Resolution Approving the Use of People's Transportation Plan (PTP) Transit Surtax Funds for Purchase/Work Orders Issued by Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) Under the Miscellaneous Construction Contracts for the Various Capital Improvements Associated with the Miami Intermodal Center-Earlington Heights (MIC-EH) Connector Project

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached resolution authorizing the use of PTP Transit Surtax (Surtax) Funds for purchase/work orders issued by Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) under the Miscellaneous Construction Contracts (MCC's) for various capital improvements in support of the MIC-Earlington Heights (MIC-EH) Connector Project.

**SCOPE**

The MIC-EH Connector Project is physically located in Commission Districts, 2, 3, 5 and 6. These purchase/work orders are in support of the MIC-EH Connector Project and therefore will have a Countywide benefit.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE**

The MIC-EH Connector Project is included among the Rapid Transit Improvements listed in Exhibit I of the PTP. Purchase/work orders listed in the attached and totaling \$715,337.08 were carried out in support of this project and will be funded by the Surtax.

This Project is funded through a combination of funding from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and proceeds from the Surtax. For FY 08-09, funding was programmed at \$526 million in the FY 08-09 adopted budget; to be funded \$100 million by FDOT and the balance, or \$426 million, from the Surtax. The total project budget is included in the FY 09-10 proposed capital plan.

**TRACK RECORD/MONITOR**

The manager responsible for these miscellaneous construction contracts is Jesus Valderrama, Manager, Contract Services/Project Control, MDT. The manager responsible for purchase and work order administration is Fred Shields, Chief, MDT Materials Management.

**DELEGATED AUTHORITY**

In accordance with Section 2-8.3 of the Miami-Dade County Code related to identifying delegation of Board authority, there are no authorities beyond that specified in the Resolution.

**BACKGROUND**

Attached is a list of purchase/work orders administered by MDT between July 2008 and March 2009 in support of the MIC-EH Connector Project, pursuant to the original Exhibit 1 of the PTP (Ordinance No. 02-116). For the projects listed, MDT accessed the Miscellaneous Construction Contracts No. 7040, approved by the Board through Resolution R-299-02. The Miscellaneous Construction Contracts were established to allow departments expedited access to contracts for construction-related services and emergency needs. Like other County departments, MDT accesses these contracts as necessary to address miscellaneous construction needs essential to the development of the MIC-EH Connector Project. The MIC/Earlington Heights Phase III Demolition, a component of the MIC-EH Connector Project, consists of the demolition and removal of structures that are located within the Project alignment.

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,
