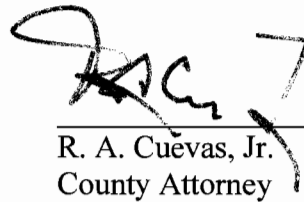

WHEREAS, Miami Christian School was chartered by the State of Florida in 1954; and

WHEREAS, Miami Christian School was accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International in 1978 and by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools in 2003; and

WHEREAS, the academic emphasis is on a well rounded program that stresses the skills in math and language arts as well as the spiritual growth through Bible studies; and

WHEREAS, Miami Christian School also accommodates ESOL students in elementary through high school; and

WHEREAS, the mascot for Miami Christian School is the Victors; and

WHEREAS, NW 109th Avenue from NW 1st Street to NW 4th Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to recognize Miami Christian School with this co-designation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed co-designation is located in County Commission District 12,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, co-designates NW 109th Avenue from NW 1st Street to NW 4th Street as "MCS Victors Way."

Section 2.
