

RESOLUTION NO. R-1135-09

RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING SW 147TH AVENUE
FROM SW 72ND STREET/SUNSET DRIVE TO SW 88TH
STREET/KENDALL DRIVE AS "LIONS CLUBS AVENUE"

WHEREAS, the International Association of Lions Clubs, often called Lions Clubs International, is a non-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, Lions Clubs International has 45,000 clubs and 1.3 million members, making it the world's largest service club organization; and

WHEREAS, many projects of the Lions Clubs in Florida are related to the needs of the blind and visually impaired, but other projects are related to help people affected by hurricanes, tornadoes and floods; and

WHEREAS, Lions Clubs Local District 35-A makes monetary contributions to local charities in excess of \$350,000 annually in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Lions Clubs Local District 35-A supports the Florida Lions Eye Bank at the Bascom Palmer Eye Institute, which provides donor eye tissue for corneal transplantation, and is involved in many other programs such as the Back to School Shopping Spree, Disaster Relief, Community Hearing Aid Bank, Guide Dogs for the Deaf, and Leader Dogs for the Blind; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Lions Clubs International with this co-designation; and

WHEREAS, SW 147th Avenue is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 11,
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, co-designates SW 147th Avenue from SW 72nd Street/Sunset Drive to SW 88th Street/Kendall Drive as “Lions Clubs Avenue.”

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Jose “Pepe” Diaz** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
