

**Subject:** Ratification of Acceptance and Execution of Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement (SJPA) 42344419401 No. 1 with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to reflect a reduction in estimated costs of a road project at MIA involving NW 67<sup>th</sup> Ave Right Of Way and Intersection Improvements

### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution ratifying the actions of the County Manager as the Mayor's Designee, pursuant to provisions of the Aviation Department's Expedite Ordinance No. 95-64, codified as Section 2-285 (6) of the Miami-Dade County Code, in accepting and executing a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement (SJPA) 42344419401 No. 1 between Miami-Dade County and the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to reflect a reduction in the estimated costs of a road project at Miami International Airport ("MIA") involving property acquisition for and roadway improvements to the intersection of NW 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Ludlum Road, SR 948/NW 36<sup>th</sup> Street, and Perimeter Road at Miami International Airport ("MIA").

### SCOPE

Miami International Airport is located within District Six. However, the impact of this project is Countywide in nature as Miami International Airport is a regional asset.

### FISCAL IMPACT

The original Joint Participation Agreement ("JPA") with FDOT provided for a total estimated project cost of \$9,988,000, with FDOT agreeing to fund the project to the extent of 50% of such cost, or \$4,994,000 and with the County through its Aviation Department agreeing to fund the balance of the project cost in an equal amount of \$4,994,000. Following the approval of the JPA, some of the original estimated costs were lowered to meet then-current estimates of costs, and the estimated acquisition cost of the right of way itself was lowered to meet current estimated costs of acquisition. The SJPA now provides for a total estimated project cost of \$6,886,434, with FDOT agreeing to fund 50% of such costs, or \$3,443,217, and with MDAD contributing the remainder. FDOT has indicated that it is willing to provide its funding of \$3,443,217 at this time, even though FDOT now estimates that the total project costs may be even less than the \$6,886,434. If a further reduction in total project costs turns out to be the case, MDAD will be required to return to FDOT that portion of the \$3,443,217 provided by FDOT that exceeds 50% of the final costs of the project.

**PROJECT MONITOR**

The project is managed by Franklin Stirrup, Facilities Project Manager. This Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement is managed by Norma Mata, Chief of Aviation Grants.

**BACKGROUND**

By Resolution No. R-158-09, adopted on March 3, 2009, the Board approved a Joint Participation Agreement between the County and FDOT under which each party would contribute \$4,994,000 for a total estimated project cost of \$9,988,000 to complete a road project on the north side of MIA.


The scope of the proposed project includes (a) the acquisition of a Right of Way (ROW) through a privately owned property located at 6600 NW 36<sup>th</sup> Street, on the East side of NW 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue between NW 36<sup>th</sup> Street and MIA's Perimeter Road, (b) the widening and repaving of NW 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue from a point starting approximately 500 feet south of MIA's Perimeter Road and running north to NW 36<sup>th</sup> Street, (c) the widening of MIA's Perimeter Road from NW 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the East for approximately 700 feet, (d) a total rebuilding of the southern portion of the intersection, (e) the modification of the westbound-to-southbound left turn lane and median of NW 36<sup>th</sup> Street, (f) installation of new traffic signals and traffic signal controllers at the intersection of NW 36<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the intersection of NW 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Perimeter Road, and (g) installation of new roadway lighting, new exfiltration trenches, and a new dry retention ponds.

FDOT has revised its estimate of total project costs for the project to be \$6,886,434, which is \$3,101,566 less than the original estimated project costs of \$9,988,000. Because both FDOT and the County split the costs under the original JPA, the reduction in estimated costs by \$3,101,566 means that FDOT's 50% funding portion amounts to a reduction in FDOT funding of \$1,550,783.

FDOT is willing to provide 50% of the reduced estimate of project costs that are now in the total amount of \$6,886,434. FDOT's funding portion is therefore \$3,443,217, with the County, through its Aviation Department, providing the other 50%, or \$3,443,217. The attached SJPA therefore reflects the reduction of total estimated project costs to \$6,886,434 and reflects FDOT's contribution of 50% of that estimated project cost which will be \$3,443,217.

If it turns out that the final project costs are even less than \$6,886,434, then the County's Aviation Department will return to FDOT that portion of FDOT's \$3,443,217 that is in excess of 50% of the final project costs.

Ratification of the County Manager's actions in accepting this SJPA No. 1 for the Miami International Airport project is therefore recommended.

RESOLUTION RELATING TO MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT; RATIFYING EXECUTION BY THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 2-285(6) OF THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CODE, OF A SUPPLEMENTAL JOINT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT (SJPA) NO. 1 WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) FOR FINANCIAL PROJECT NO. 42344419401 TO REFLECT A REDUCTION IN FDOT'S FUNDING DUE TO A REDUCTION IN THE ESTIMATED PROJECT COSTS FROM \$9,988,000 TO \$6,886,434; AUTHORIZING RETURN TO FDOT OF ANY PORTION OF FDOT'S CURRENT FUNDING UNDER THE SJPA THAT EXCEEDS FIFTY PERCENT OF FINAL PROJECT COSTS

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum and documents, copies of which are incorporated herein by reference,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board approves, ratifies, and confirms the actions of the Mayor or his designee, pursuant to the provisions of Section 2-285(6) of the Miami-Dade County Code, in accepting and executing a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement (SJPA) Number 1 between Miami-Dade County and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for Financial Project No. 42344419401 to reflect a reduction in FDOT's funding due to a reduction in the estimated project costs from the original estimate of \$9,988,000 to the current estimated project costs of \$6,886,434, with FDOT's 50% funding of such reduced project costs being in the amount of \$3,443,217; authorizes the Mayor or Designee to return to FDOT from available Aviation Department funds any portion of FDOT's 50% funding of the project that exceeds 50% of the final project costs.
