



RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE OCTOBER 24, 2009 "STEP FORWARD" SPONSORED BY TUBEROUS SCLEROSIS ALLIANCE, A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,962.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE UNSPENT BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 7 FY 2008-09 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

**WHEREAS**, Tuberos Sclerosis Alliance, has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department and the Miami-Dade Police Department for the October 24, 2009 "Step Forward" in an amount not to exceed \$1,962.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

**WHEREAS**, the "Step Forward" is a walkathon to raise funds for tuberous sclerosis research and provide family support services; and

**WHEREAS**, Tuberos Sclerosis Alliance, is a not-for-profit organization; and

**WHEREAS**, the "Step Forward" is a small event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$1, 962.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the unspent balance of the District 7 FY 2008-09 In-kind Reserve Fund,






Dear Sir or Madam:

This is in response to your request of January 24, 2003, regarding your organization's tax exempt status.

Our records indicate that a determination letter issued in October 1975 granted your organization exemption from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. That letter is still in effect.

Based on information subsequently submitted, we classified your organization as one that is not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code because it is an organization described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi).

This classification was based on the assumption that your organization's operations would continue as stated in the application. If your organization's sources of support, or its character, method of operations, or purposes have changed, please let us know so we can consider the effect of the change on the exempt status and foundation status of your organization.

Your organization is required to file Form 990, Return of Organization Exempt from Income Tax, only if its gross receipts each year are normally more than \$25,000. If a return is required, it must be filed by the 15th day of the fifth month after the end of the organization's annual accounting period. The law imposes a penalty of \$20 a day, up to a maximum of \$10,000, when a return is filed late, unless there is reasonable cause for the delay.

All exempt organizations (unless specifically excluded) are liable for taxes under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (social security taxes) on remuneration of \$100 or more paid to each employee during a calendar year. Your organization is not liable for the tax imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA).

Organizations that are not private foundations are not subject to the excise taxes under Chapter 42 of the Code. However, these organizations are not automatically exempt from other federal excise taxes.

Donors may deduct contributions to your organization as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to your organization or for its use are deductible for federal estate and gift tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of sections 2055, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.

Your organization is not required to file federal income tax returns unless it is subject to the tax on unrelated business income under section 511 of the Code. If your organization is subject to this tax, it must file an income tax return on the Form 990-T, Exempt Organization Business Income Tax Return. In this letter, we are not determining whether any of your organization's present or proposed activities are unrelated trade or business as defined in section 513 of the Code.


The law requires you to make your organization's annual return available for public inspection without charge for three years after the due date of the return. If your organization had a copy of its application for recognition of exemption on July 15, 1987, it is also required to make available for public inspection a copy of the exemption application, any supporting documents and the exemption letter to any individual who requests such documents in person or in writing. You can charge only a reasonable fee for reproduction and actual postage costs for the copied materials. The law does not require you to provide copies of public inspection documents that are widely available, such as by posting them on the Internet (World Wide Web). You may be liable for a penalty of \$20 a day for each day you do not make these documents available for public inspection (up to a maximum of \$10,000 in the case of an annual return).

Because this letter could help resolve any questions about your organization's exempt status and foundation status, you should keep it with the organization's permanent records.

**Subject:** District Specific In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

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The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends this item move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district in-kind reserve balance allows for funding of this request.

## Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization, Tuberous Sclerosis Alliance, for their "Step Forward" event held on October 24, 2009.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$1,362 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the use of a 24'X40' stage and open area rental fee at Crandon Park; and \$600 from the Miami-Dade Police Department for police services for a total in-kind of \$1,962. This event will be funded from the District 7 FY 2008-09 in-kind reserve fund unspent balance.

In FY 2009-10, the Tuberous Sclerosis Alliance has received no county funding for this event.
