Subject: In-Kind Services Recommendation for South Florida Workforce Investment Board

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached Resolution authorizing in-kind services for the South Florida Workforce Investment Board in an amount totaling \$7,655.

BACKGROUND

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by the South Florida Workforce Investment Board for the "Training Expo 2009" event held on October 29, 2009.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$6,500 from the Miami-Dade Police Department for personnel services and \$1,155 from the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department for personnel services for a total in-kind of \$7,655. At the request of the Mayor, this event will be funded in part from the Mayor's FY 2008-09 in-kind reserve fund unspent balance and in part from the unspent balance of the non-ad valorem portion of the Fire Rescue district budget.

In FY 2009-10, the South Florida Workforce Investment Board has received no county funding for this event.

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE MIAMI-DADE FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT FOR THE OCTOBER 29, 2009 "TRAINING EXPO 2009" SPONSORED BY SOUTH FLORIDA WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$7,655.00 TO BE FUNDED IN PART FROM THE UNSPENT BALANCE OF THE MAYOR'S FY 2008-09 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND AND IN PART FROM THE UNSPENT BALANCE OF THE NON-AD VALOREM PORTION OF THE FIRE RESCUE DISTRICT BUDGET

WHEREAS, South Florida Workforce Investment Board, has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Police Department and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department for the October 29, 2009 "Training Expo 2009" in an amount not to exceed \$7,655.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the "Training Expo 2009" is to offer free occupational training workshops for residents of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the "Training Expo 2009" is a small event, as defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$6,500.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the unspent balance of the Mayor's FY 2008-09 In-kind Reserve Fund and \$1,155.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the unspent balance of the non-ad valorem portion of the Fire Rescue District Budget,
