

Subject: Contract Award Recommendation-between H&R Paving, Inc. and Miami-Dade
Aviation Department for TMB Runway 9R-27L in the amount of \$4,452,919.58

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached Contract Award Recommendation in the amount of \$4,452,919.58 between H&R Paving, Inc., and Miami-Dade County for TMB Runway 9R-27L.

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The authority of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute and implement this contract is consistent with those authorities granted under the Code of Miami-Dade County. Additional delegations of authorities requested for this contract are as follows: to exercise any cancellation and termination provisions contained in this contract.

SCOPE

PROJECT NAME: TMB Runway 9R-27L Extension

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: This project will consist of the 1,000-foot westward extension of TMB Runway 9R/27L for an overall length of 6,000 feet. The lengthening of the runway by 1,000 feet will include the westward extension of the 50-foot wide parallel Taxiway "E" and the construction of a runway to taxiway entrance/exit connector. Other related construction work shall include airfield drainage, airfield signage, runway & taxiway pavement markings, pavement grooving, Medium Intensity Taxiway Lights (MITL), High Intensity Runway Edge Lights (HIRL), and the relocation of all visual and electronic NAVAIDS including replacing the existing Visual Approach Slope Indicator (VASI) with a Precision Approach Path Indicators (PAPIs), the Localizer, Glide Slope and the Runway Medium Intensity Approach Lighting System with Runway Alignment Indicator Lights (MALSR).

EXPLANATION:

This project was advertised as an Invitation to Bid on June 25, 2009. Twelve (12) bids were received and opened on July 27, 2009. The bids were reviewed for contract and DBE compliance and a bid tabulation was prepared by CSA Group, Inc., the consulting engineer. The low bidder offered a bid of \$4,038,929.32, which is 49.5% under the Engineer's Estimate of \$8,000,000.00. The second low bidder offered \$4,513,713.71 which is 11.8% higher than the low bidder. The third low bidder was 5.5% above the second low bidder. According to the Engineer of Record, the rather significant difference in price from the Engineer's estimate is due to the extreme economic condition presently affecting pricing of construction worldwide (see letter attached). As a result of the analysis performed, H&R Paving, Inc., was deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and is recommended for award.

BACKGROUND:

TMB is one of the designated general aviation relievers to Miami International Airport and one of the busiest general aviation airports in South Florida. Currently, aircraft using this airport are limited in their takeoff weight due to the current runway length, thus preventing them from departing with a full allotment of aviation fuel, cargo capacity, or both. This proposed increase in runway length will allow aircraft to increase their fuel and/or cargo load and allow them to arrive at destinations and markets that are currently unattainable without first having to land and refuel at other airports. This project includes the extension of Runway 9R-27L from 5,002 x 150 feet to 6,002 x 150 feet and also the extension of the 50 foot wide asphaltic parallel Taxiway "E" Echo. Other related work shall include required airfield signage and runway & taxiway pavement markings, Medium Intensity Taxiway Lights (MITL), High Intensity Runway Edge Lights (HIRL), and the relocation of all visual and electronic NAVAIDS including replacing the existing Precision Approach Path Indicators (PAPIs) with a Visual Approach Slope Indicator (VASI), the Localizer, Glide Slope and the Runway Medium Intensity Approach Lighting System with Runway Alignment Indicator Lights (MALSR).

CSA Group has completed the bid analysis and recommendation for award. Enclosed you will find the Bid Tabulation Summary, Bid Tabulation Analysis and Bid Envelopes.

The enclosed documentation shows the lowest bid to be from H & R Paving Inc. in the amount of \$4,452,919.58. This represents a cost of approximately 46% below the Engineer's estimate of \$9,658,254.41. The bids ranged from \$4,452,919.58 to \$6,987,652.61


The comparison of bid item unit prices provides information on the lowest, highest and average prices for each item along with the Engineer's estimate price for each bid item. The tabulation analysis shows the bid item unit prices and totals as submitted by the contractors. The bid amounts are verified by multiplying the unit quantities by the item unit prices provided by the contractors. A few discrepancies were found in the bid amounts, and they ranged from \$ 0.60 to \$ 10,800.00. However, the \$ 0.60 discrepancy was with the low bidder. The rather significant difference in price from the Engineer's estimate is due to the extreme economic conditions presently affecting pricing of construction worldwide.

The bid tabulation summary provided a checklist of all required documents for each bid. H & R paving included all the required forms with their bid. Lemartec Engineering failed to submit Letters of Intent from their DBE subcontractors and therefore is considered non responsive.

Based upon the bid analysis CSA Group recommends the award of the contract to the lowest responsive bidder, H & R Paving, Inc.

Summary

This resolution approves the contract award recommendation in the amount of \$4,452,919.58 between H&R Paving, Inc. and Miami-Dade County for the 1,000-foot westward extension and other related construction work to the Kendall-Tamiami Executive Airport (TMB) Runway 9R-27L, Project No. L141A. The proposed increase in runway length will allow aircraft to increase their fuel and/or cargo load and allow them to arrive at destinations and markets that are currently unattainable without first having to land and refuel at other airports. The contract term is 493 calendar days from the effective date established in the Notice to Proceed.

The project was advertised as an Invitation to Bid (ITB) on June 25, 2009 and nineteen (19) bid packages were issued. On July 27, 2009, twelve (12) bids were received and reviewed for contract and DBE compliance. The low bid was H&R Paving, Inc. with a bid of \$4,038,929.32 which is 49.5% lower than the engineer's base estimate of \$8,000,000.

The bids received range from the lowest bid of \$4,038,929 to the highest bid of \$6,338,006.

- *According to CSA Group, the consulting engineer, in a letter dated July 31, 2009, "The rather significant difference in price from the Engineer's estimate is due to the extreme economic conditions presently affecting pricing of construction worldwide.*
- *Additionally, MDAD received a letter dated January 11, 2010, from Berkley Regional Insurance Company, as surety consenting and acknowledging to MDAD, the validity of the captioned bid bond extended to April 22, 1010.*

The DBE contract measures assigned were 16.2% with an estimated value of \$719,737. The contract measures achieved are 22.4% with an estimated value of \$995,192. The subcontractors listed for this project are the following:

Background

According to the Department of Small Business Development, H&R Paving’s three previous make-up plans to satisfy a \$220,000 goal deficit have been achieved as of June 24, 2009.

The Department of Small Business Development Violations Report dated January 8, 2010, lists three (3) closed violations for failing to meet CSBE subcontractor goal with a makeup amount totaling \$220,982.

Relevant Legislation

At the December 4, 2009, Airport and Seaport Committee meeting a resolution was passed approving the First Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement (PSA) between Miami-Dade County and Brown & Brown Architects, and will be placed on the January 21, 2010, Board of County Commissioners Meeting Agenda for consideration.

Brown & Brown Architects, designed the extension of the TMB Runway 9R-27L, Project No. L141A. MDAD has an opportunity to take advantage of available matching State funds that may be available to further improve the safety of the runway by extending it to its full permitted length.
