RESOLUTION NO. R-71-10

RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE,
GOVERNOR CHARLIE CRIST AND THE FLORIDA
DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS & PROFESSIONAL
REGULATION TO APPROVE THE REINSTATEMENT OF
THOROUGHBRED RACING AT HIALEAH PARK RACE
TRACK

WHEREAS, Hialeah Park Race Track officially opened on January 14, 1932 to conduct thoroughbred racing; and

WHEREAS, through the years, Hialeah Park gained a reputation as the premier winter thoroughbred race course in the U.S.; and

WHEREAS, Hialeah Park also introduced international thoroughbred racing to the U.S.; and

WHEREAS, in March 5, 1979, Hialeah Park was listed on the National Registry of Historic Places because of its historic significance, worldwide recognition and contributions to the thoroughbred industry; and

WHEREAS, the last thoroughbred race at Hialeah Park was run on May 22, 2001, after a change in state law kept Hialeah Park from having certain exclusive racing dates; and

WHEREAS, on November 28, 2009, Hialeah Park reopened for the running of quarter horse races; and

WHEREAS, Hialeah Park now seeks to reinstate thoroughbred racing; and

WHEREAS, this Board supports the reinstatement of thoroughbred racing at Hialeah Park,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the Florida Legislature, Governor Charlie Crist and the Florida Department of Business & Professional Regulation to take all actions necessary and appropriate to approve the reinstatement of thoroughbred racing at Hialeah Park Race Track.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this resolution to the Governor, Senate President, House Speaker, the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation and the Secretary of the Florida Department of Business & Professional Regulation.

Section 3. Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the issues identified in section 1 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to include this item in the 2010 state legislative package.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner **Jose "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Barbara J. Jordan** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
