RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING SW 76TH STREET FROM SW 107TH AVENUE TO SW 117TH AVENUE AS "OFFICER GIOVANNI L. GONZALEZ STREET"

WHEREAS, Officer Giovanni L. Gonzalez, a Miami native, graduated from Coral Gables Senior High School in 2004 and joined the Miami-Dade Police Department in 2006; and

WHEREAS, upon graduating from the police academy, Officer Gonzalez was assigned to the Kendall District where he served in uniform patrol and in the Priority Service Unit; and

WHEREAS, during his short law enforcement career, Officer Gonzalez received eight commendations; and

WHEREAS, Officer Giovanni L. Gonzalez passed away on June 16, 2009 from injuries suffered in an on-duty vehicle crash; and

WHEREAS, SW 76th Street from SW 107th Avenue to SW 117th Avenue is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Officer Giovanni L. Gonzalez by codesignating SW 76th Street from SW 107th Avenue to SW 117th Avenue as "Officer Giovanni L. Gonzalez Street"; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 76th Street from SW 107th Avenue to SW 117th Avenue as "Officer Giovanni L. Gonzalez Street".
