

RESOLUTION NO. R-334-10

RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING SW 76<sup>TH</sup> STREET FROM SW 107<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE TO SW 117<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE AS "OFFICER GIOVANNI L. GONZALEZ STREET"

**WHEREAS**, Officer Giovanni L. Gonzalez, a Miami native, graduated from Coral Gables Senior High School in 2004 and joined the Miami-Dade Police Department in 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, upon graduating from the police academy, Officer Gonzalez was assigned to the Kendall District where he served in uniform patrol and in the Priority Service Unit; and

**WHEREAS**, during his short law enforcement career, Officer Gonzalez received eight commendations; and

**WHEREAS**, Officer Giovanni L. Gonzalez passed away on June 16, 2009 from injuries suffered in an on-duty vehicle crash; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 76<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor the memory of Officer Giovanni L. Gonzalez by codesignating SW 76<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue as "Officer Giovanni L. Gonzalez Street"; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 76<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue as "Officer Giovanni L. Gonzalez Street".

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner Sen. Javier D. Souto, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
