RESOLUTION NO. R-532-10

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CO-DESIGNATION BY THE CITY OF HIALEAH OF EAST 26TH STREET BETWEEN EAST 7TH AVENUE AND EAST 8TH AVENUE AS “DR. OLIVER ANDERSON DRIVE”

**WHEREAS**, on February 23, 2010, the Hialeah City Council adopted Resolution No. 10-22, co-designating East 26th Street between East 7th Avenue and East 8th Avenue as “Dr. Oliver Anderson Drive,” a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, East 26th Street from East 7th Avenue to East 8th Avenue is a city street located within the City of Hialeah; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah wants the County to install signage indicating this City street co-designation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

**WHEREAS**, this co-designation is located in County Commission District 13,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the co-designation by the City of Hialeah of East 26th Street between East 7th Avenue and East 8th Avenue as “Dr. Oliver Anderson Drive.”

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the City of Hialeah Mayor and City Council, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department, the Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Hialeah Police Department and the Hialeah Fire Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Natacha Seijas. It was offered by Commissioner **Natacha Seijas**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Dennis C. Moss** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-22**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE CO-DESIGNATION OF A PORTION OF EAST 26 STREET, BETWEEN EAST 7 AVENUE AND EAST 8 AVENUE, HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AS "DR. OLIVER ANDERSON DRIVE", IN HONOR AND RECOGNITION OF THE OUTSTANDING SERVICE AND DEDICATION OF DR. OLIVER ANDERSON TO THE CITY OF HIALEAH AND ITS RESIDENTS, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY.

**WHEREAS**, the co-designation of that portion of East 26 Street, between East 7 Avenue and East 8 Avenue, as "DR. OLIVER ANDERSON DRIVE", presently unnamed, is in honor and recognition of the outstanding service and dedication of Dr. Oliver Anderson; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Anderson was instrumental in the creation and building of Hialeah Hospital, as one of the hospital's original founders; and

**WHEREAS**, for more than 50 years, Dr. Anderson gave his time and effort to serve the residents of Hialeah and the surrounding communities, both as a physician at Hialeah Hospital and as a philanthropist; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Anderson has practiced medicine in Hialeah for the past 54 years and now, although in his 90's, remains committed to charitable endeavors; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Anderson and his family have remained instrumental in ensuring that Hialeah Hospital has been able to maintain the funding needed to continue providing high-quality service and patient care; and


**WHEREAS**, the Historic Preservation Board recommended approval of this resolution on February 12, 2010.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:**

**Section 1:** The portion of East 26 Street, between East 7 Avenue and East 8 Avenue, Hialeah, Florida, presently unnamed, is hereby co-designated as "DR. OLIVER


ANDERSON DRIVE", and shall be known as such from this day forward, with the costs of signage to be paid by the City.


