

RESOLUTION NO. **R-533-10** _____

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CO-DESIGNATION BY THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES OF NW 82ND AVENUE/MONTROSE ROAD FROM NW 154TH STREET TO OAK LANE AS "BOY SCOUT ROAD"

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2009, the Miami Lakes Town Council adopted Resolution No. 09-775, co-designating NW 82nd Avenue/Montrose Road from NW 154th Street to Oak Lane as "Boy Scout Road", a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, NW 82nd Avenue/Montrose Road from NW 154th Street to Oak Lane is a city street located within the boundaries of the Town of Miami Lakes; and

WHEREAS, this road co-designation is located in County Commission District 13,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the co-designation by the Town of Miami Lakes of NW 82nd Avenue/Montrose Road from NW 154th Street to Oak Lane as "Boy Scout Road."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Miami Lake Town Council, the Miami Lakes Town Manager, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Natacha Seijas. It was offered by Commissioner **Natacha Seijas**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 09-775

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, CO-DESIGNATING 82nd AVENUE/MONTROSE ROAD BETWEEN NORTHWEST 154TH STREET AND OAK LANE AS 82nd AVENUE/"BOY SCOUT" ROAD; AUTHORIZING TOWN OFFICIALS TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO DESIGNATE THE ROAD; DIRECTING THE CLERK TO NOTIFY THE UNITED STATES POST OFFICE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts Of America will celebrate its 100th year in 2010; and

WHEREAS, the South Florida Council of the Boy Scouts of America makes its home in the Town of Miami Lakes; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of 100 years of service and commitment to this Nation and to the young men of the Town of Miami Lakes, the Town Council desires to re-name and co-designate 82nd Avenue/Montrose Road between Northwest 154th Street and Oak Lane as 82nd Avenue/"Boy Scout" Road; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-1, Rule 9.02 of the Town Code (Miami-Dade County as made applicable to the Town pursuant to the Town Charter) the Town Council has held a public hearing to consider the designation of the roadway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing Recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Designation of Roadway. 82nd Avenue/Montrose Road between Northwest 154th Street and Oak Lane is designated as 82nd Avenue/"Boy Scout" Road.

Section 3. Authorization of Town Officials. The Town Manager and/or his designee and the Town Attorney are authorized to take all actions necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4. Direction to Clerk. The Town Clerk is directed to send a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service in order to verify the street designation for postal records.


Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


