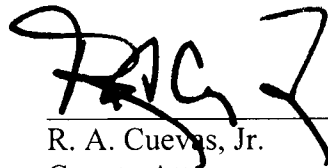

**RESOLUTION NO. R-462-10**

**RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING SW 69<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE FROM  
SW 8<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO SW 16<sup>TH</sup> STREET AS “EUGENIO PINO  
WAY”**

**WHEREAS**, Eugenio Pino was born in Camaguey in 1930 where he started working at the age of 14; and

**WHEREAS**, at the age of 23, Eugenio Pino started his own business, a small grocery store, and kept it until it was confiscated by the Cuban government in 1968; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1969, Mr. Pino arrived in Miami with his wife Helia and two sons, Sergio and Carlos; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Pino started working as a plumber helper, eventually got his license and in 1973, started his own plumbing business; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1977, Pino gave his son Sergio \$6,000 to purchase a small plumbing company and after two years, Pino joined his son in the business; and

**WHEREAS** over the next three decades, Pino built “La Familia Century Plumbing” into one of the most important plumbing suppliers in South Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the College of Business Administration at FIU has named its Entrepreneurial Center the “Eugenio Pino and Family Global Entrepreneurial Center” (the Pino Center) in recognition of Pino’s achievements; and

**WHEREAS**, the Eugenio Pino and Family Center’s mission is to “create entrepreneurial leaders and organizations in all segments of society, throughout South Florida and internationally”; and

**WHEREAS**, since the Center's inception in 2003, approximately 2,500 undergraduate-level students, 600 graduate-level students, and 12 doctoral-level students have been affected by the activities, courses, and programs associated with Pino Entrepreneurial Center at FIU; and

**WHEREAS**, the programs offered by the Pino Center focus on fostering a business environment based on four strategies: "*International*" meaning focusing on global, "*Innovation*" meaning focusing on nurturing innovation based firms, "*Inflection Point*" in the maturation of business relationships, and "*Involvement*" of strategic partnerships; and

**WHEREAS**, undoubtedly, the educational contributions of the Pino Center have affected the local economy of Miami-Dade County in a positive manner, reaffirming South Florida as being one of the most commercially dynamic locations in the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, Pino retired in 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor Eugenio Pino by co designating SW 69<sup>th</sup> Avenue from SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 16<sup>th</sup> Street as "Eugenio Pino Way"; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 69<sup>th</sup> Avenue from SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 16<sup>th</sup> Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 6,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

Section 1. Finds that Eugenio Pino has made a direct, significant lifetime contribution to this community.

Section 2. Having considered this matter at a public hearing and by a three-fifths vote of the Board members present, co-designates SW 69<sup>th</sup> Avenue from SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 16<sup>th</sup> Street as "Eugenio Pino Way".

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sen. Javier D. Souto** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
