

RESOLUTION NO. R-769-10

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE STATE CO-DESIGNATION  
OF BIRD ROAD/SW 40 STREET FROM SW 87 AVENUE TO  
SW 89 AVENUE AS "BOB ARBETTER'S WAY"

**WHEREAS**, during the 2010 regular session, the Florida Legislature passed and the Governor signed into law CS/CS/HB 29 which, among other state road co-designations, co-designated Bird Road/SW 40 Street from SW 87 Avenue to SW 89 Avenue as "Bob Arbetter's Way"; and

**WHEREAS**, Bird Road/SW 40 Street from SW 87 Avenue to SW 89 Avenue is a state road located in Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the installation of road designation signs shall be contingent on the applicable county or city commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary road designation; and

**WHEREAS**, this co-designation is located in County Commission District 10,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Approves the state road co-designation of Bird Road/SW 40 Street from SW 87 Avenue to SW 89 Avenue as "Bob Arbetter's Way".

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation and the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
