**Subject:** Resolution Declaring the Acquisition of a 50-Foot Strip of Land known as Parcel 101 Required for the Construction of a Utility Corridor for the South District Water Reclamation Plant, to be a Public Necessity

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approve the attached resolution declaring the acquisition of Parcel 101 which is required for the construction of a utility corridor for the County's South District Water Reclamation Plant (SDWRP) at the southwest corner of SW 236 Street and SW 97 Avenue, to be a public necessity; and to employ appraisers, expert witnesses, obtain required environmental audits, and authorizing the County Mayor or the County Mayor's Designee and County Attorney to take any and all appropriate action to acquire the subject parcel in fee simple, either by negotiation, purchase at values established by appraisals, donation, or eminent domain court proceedings including declaration of taking as necessary for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County. The property is currently owned by Radeconde Fernandez, and Elsa L and Andy Fernandez, as per the Miami-Dade County Tax Collector.

## SCOPE

The project is located in Commission District 8.

## FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

The funding source for the acquisition of Parcel 101 is Wastewater Plant Expansion Funds (Wastewater Connection Charges) and is funded as part of the larger project budget of \$330,000,000. There will be no impact on the County's current approved capital budget. Preliminary estimates for operations and maintenance (O&M) costs associated with this new facility are approximately \$13,000,000 per year which will be funded through WASD operating revenues.

## BACKGROUND

The construction of the SDWRP is a requirement of the County's 20-Year Water Use Permit (WUP) issued by the South Florida Water Management District in November 2007. The South District Water Reclamation Plant will generate 21 million gallons of highly treated water daily for recharge of the aquifer and must be operational by 2014.

The acquisition of a 50 foot strip of land known as Parcel 101 along SW 236 Street (see attached Exhibit B) provides the road access necessary to link the South District Waste Water Treatment Plant (SDWWTP) to the SDWRP and will serve as part of the utility corridor that includes a:

6-inch hypochlorite pipeline from the South District SDWWTP to SDWRP  
24-inch reverse osmosis reject water pipeline from the SDWRP to SDWWTP  
42-inch diameter finished product water pipeline from SDWRP to Metro Zoo  
48-inch diameter influent pipeline from the SDWWTP to SDWRP  
FPL Electric Duct banks from SW 232 Street to SDWRP

There may also be other pipelines and communication facilities between the SDWWTP and SDWRP which have not been identified and/or confirmed at this point in design.

The selected alignment along SW 236 Street will provide a substantial savings in construction, less interruption of traffic flow, less pipeline congestion along SW 97 Avenue, and a secondary access route for the operation of the SDWRP.

RESOLUTION NO. R-894-10

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ACQUISITION OF THE DESIGNATED PROPERTY KNOWN AS PARCEL ONE-HUNDRED AND ONE (101) NEEDED TO CONSTRUCT THE SOUTH DISTRICT WATER RECLAMATION PLANT UTILITY CORRIDOR TO BE A PUBLIC NECESSITY AND TO EMPLOY APPRAISERS, EXPERT WITNESSES, OBTAIN REQUIRED ENVIRONMENTAL AUDITS, AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE AND COUNTY ATTORNEY TO TAKE ANY AND ALL APPROPRIATE ACTION TO ACQUIRE THE SUBJECT PARCEL IN FEE SIMPLE, EITHER BY NEGOTIATION, PURCHASE AT VALUES ESTABLISHED BY APPRAISALS, DONATION, OR EMINENT DOMAIN COURT PROCEEDINGS INCLUDING DECLARATION OF TAKING AS NECESSARY FOR AND ON BEHALF OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board finds and declares the acquisition of Parcel 101 in fee simple as legally described in Exhibit "A" and shown in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the public purpose of a utility corridor to create connectivity between the South District Waste Water Treatment Plant and the South District Water Reclamation Plant to be required and necessary to accomplish this utility corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County is authorized under the Constitution and laws of Florida, including Chapters 73, 74, 125 and 127, Florida Statutes, and Sections 1.01 (A) (1), (2) and (21), of the Home Rule Charter of Miami-Dade County, to acquire said property by eminent domain proceedings,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:**

**Section 1.** This Board ratifies and adopts these matters set forth in the foregoing recitals.

**Section 2.** This Board finds and declares that the acquisition of Parcel 101 as legally described in “Exhibit A” attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is needed for the public purpose of a utility corridor.

**Section 3.** This Board authorizes and directs the County Mayor or the County Mayor’s designee and the County Attorney to employ appraisers, review appraisers and expert witnesses, to obtain required environmental audits and to take any action to acquire Parcel 101 in fee simple, as legally described in Exhibit “A” by donation, purchase at values established by appraisals or eminent domain proceedings, including a declaration of taking, as necessary for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County.

**Section 4.** Pursuant to Resolution R-974-09, this Board (a) directs the County Mayor or the County Mayor’s designee to record the instruments of conveyances accepted herein in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida; and provide a recorded copy of instruments to the Clerk of the Board within thirty (30) days of execution of said instruments: and (b) directs the Clerk of the Board to attach and permanently store a recorded copy of said instruments together with this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner **Dorrin D. Rolle** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


**SKETCH OF 50 FEET


