Subject: MDPHA CARVER

Recommendation

The following plat is hereby submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners for approval. The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval and recording of the plat listed below. This plat is bounded on the north by NW 75 Street, on the east by NW 19 Avenue, on the south by Florida East Coast Railway right-of-way, and on the west by NW 21 Avenue.

Scope

This plat is located within the boundaries of Commission District 2.

Fiscal Impact /Funding Source

If this plat is approved, the fiscal impact to the County would be approximately \$1,051.09 per year for annual maintenance cost once the roads are constructed within and adjacent to the property, and will be funded through the General Fund.

Background

MDPHA CARVER (T-23095)

- Located in Section 10, Township 53 South, Range 41 East
- Commission District: 2
- Zoning: RU-4
- Proposed Usage: The area encompassed by this plat lies within Phase II of the Scott/Carver Homes HOPEVI Revitalization Project. This plat consists of 106 mixed-income rental apartments within 27 proposed apartment buildings.
- Number of parcels: 4
- This plat meets concurrency

Plat Restrictions

- That NW 19th Avenue, NW 19th Court, NW 20th Court, NW 21st Avenue, NW 73rd Street and NW 74th Street Terrace, as illustrated on the plat, together with all existing and future planting, trees, shrubbery and fire hydrants thereon, are hereby dedicated to the perpetual use of the public for proper purposes, reserving to the dedicators, their successors or assigns, the reversion or reversions thereof whenever discontinued by law.
- That individual wells shall not be permitted within this subdivision, except for swimming pools, sprinkler systems and/or air conditioners.
- That the use of septic tanks will not be permitted within this subdivision, unless approved for temporary use, in accordance with County and State regulations.
- That all new electric and communication lines, except transmission lines, within this subdivision, shall be installed underground.
- That Tracts "A", "B" and "C", as illustrated on the plat, shall be owned and maintained by Miami-Dade County through its Housing Department, the Miami-Dade County Housing Agency, or its successors, as designated by the appropriate Miami-Dade County authority.

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- That Tract "D", as illustrated on the plat, is hereby reserved for park purposes, and shall be owned and maintained by Miami-Dade County through its Housing Department, the Miami-Dade Public Housing Agency, or its successors as designated by the appropriate Miami-Dade County Authority.

Developer's Obligation

- Paving, milling, resurfacing, sidewalks, curb and gutter, valley gutter, curb, drainage, street name signs, traffic control signs, striping, landscaping and monumentation. Miami-Dade Public Housing Authority indicated that funds in the amount of \$738,596.00 have been allocated for the construction of the aforementioned improvements.

RESOLUTION NO. R-859-10

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAT OF MDPHA CARVER, LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 53 SOUTH, RANGE 41 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY NW 75 STREET, ON THE EAST BY NW 19 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY THE FLORIDA EAST COAST RAILWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND ON THE WEST BY NW 21 AVENUE)

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, has this day presented to this Board a plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said plat to be known as MDPHA CARVER, the same being a replat of Tract 1 of "Public Housing Project Florida 5-20", according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 84, at Page 31, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, lying and being in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 10, Township 53 South, Range 41 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that said plat is hereby approved; that the dedication of the streets, alleys and other rights-of-way however designated or depicted on said plat is hereby accepted; that the Miami-Dade County Plat Restrictions as listed on said plat are approved and are to be enforced; that approval of the plat is not a waiver of any zoning regulations and that the requirements of the zoning existing on this land at the time this resolution is approved shall be enforced whether or not the various parcels on this plat conform to those requirements; this approval is conditioned upon the proper execution of all documents required by the County Attorney's Office.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner **Dorrin D. Rolle**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Audrey M. Edmonson** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


