

RESOLUTION NO. R-1207-10

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO
PREPARE A REPORT REGARDING COUNTY LEASES

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County owns a number of buildings and other real property that it leases to private entities, not-for-profit entities and governmental entities, including space at airports, the seaport and parks; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County also leases a number of buildings and other real property from private entities and other governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, while the Board is required to approve all leases, a report of all real property currently leased by or to the County would provide the Board with a global perspective,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Directs the Mayor or designee to prepare a report regarding County leases, including all property leased by the County to other entities and to the County from other entities. For each particular leased building or other real property, the report shall address, at a minimum:

1. The street address of the leased space;
2. The name of the entity to which or from which the County leases the space;
3. The amount the County receives or pays for each lease per month and what services are included, such as utilities and janitorial;
4. The square footage of the space leased to or from the County;
5. The duration of the current lease term;

6. The length and number of any renewal options that may be available and the terms of such renewal options;
7. The terms of any cancellation provisions included in the lease;
8. The length of time the particular building or space has been leased to or from the other entity;
9. The percentage of space leased to or from the County that is occupied;
10. The percentage of space leased to or from the County that is vacant or unused;
and
11. The funding source for the payment of the rent if the County is the lessee.

Section 2. The report shall be placed on the appropriate Commission committee agenda within sixty (60) days from the adoption of this resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
