RESOLUTION NO. R-1208-10

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF SWEETWATER
CO-DESIGNATION OF NW 112TH AVENUE FROM WEST
FLAGLER STREET TO NW 7TH STREET AS “RAUL P.
RODRIGUEZ BOULEVARD”

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2010, the Mayor and Commission of the City of Sweetwater adopted Resolution No. 3500, which designated NW 112th Avenue from West Flagler Street to NW 7th Street as “Raul P. Rodriguez Boulevard,” in recognition of his contributions to the City of Sweetwater, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rodriguez purchased the Li'l Abner Mobile Home Park over 30 years ago and made it his goal to become part of the Sweetwater community; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rodriguez was a powerful influence in the growth and progress of the City of Sweetwater; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rodriguez passed away on August 12, 2010; and

WHEREAS, NW 112th Avenue from West Flagler Street to NW 7th Street is a city street located in the City of Sweetwater; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sweetwater wants the County to install signage indicating this co-designation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this co-designation is located in County Commission District 12,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Sweetwater co-designation of NW 112th Avenue from West Flagler Street to NW 7th Street as “Raul P. Rodriguez Boulevard.”

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor of the City of Sweetwater, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and

Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Sweetwater Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Vice-Chairman Jose "Pepe" Diaz. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SWEETWATER, FLORIDA, HONORING THE MEMORY OF RAUL P. RODRIGUEZ BY DESIGNATING N.W. 112 AVENUE BETWEEN WEST FLAGLER STREET AND N.W. 7 STREET IN THE CITY OF SWEETWATER TO ALSO BE KNOWN AS RAUL P. RODRIGUEZ BOULEVARD; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Raul P. Rodriguez purchased the L. H. Abner Mobile Home Park over 30 years ago making it his goal to become part of the Sweetwater community; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Rodriguez was active in civic affairs and projects never turning away any request for participation or assistance, and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Rodriguez demonstrated in many different ways his deep and genuine love for this city by becoming a powerful influence for good in its growth and progress, and,

WHEREAS, Raul P. Rodriguez passed away on August 13, 2010 leaving our citizens with a deep feeling of sorrow for the loss of such an honored and respected member of our community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SWEETWATER, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and City Commission of the City of Sweetwater, on behalf of the entire community, do hereby express deep grief and extend their condolences to the bereaved family of Raul P. Rodriguez.

SECTION 2. That the City wishes to memorialize his contributions to the City of Sweetwater and its citizens by naming N.W. 112 Avenue between West Flagler Street and N.W. 7 Street in the City of Sweetwater as Raul P. Rodriguez Boulevard.

SECTION 2. That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Miami-Dade County Public Works Department.

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SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the City Commission and approval by the Mayor or if vetoed, upon its reenactment by the City Commission as provided by the Charter of the City of Sweetwater.
