



ORDINANCE NO. 11-18

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-1312 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, RELATING TO THE DIAL-A-LIFE BOARD; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONER APPOINTED TO THE BOARD TO APPOINT AN INDIVIDUAL TO SIT IN HIS OR HER PLACE ON THE BOARD; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 2-1312 (D) 1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:¹

Sec. 2-1312. [Program board.]

* * * *

D. Board Membership.

1. Members. The Board shall be composed of the following members: a County Commissioner to be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners>>, or his or her appointee <<; one (1) member who shall be selected and appointed by the County Manager; one (1) member of the Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue Department who shall be appointed by the Director; one (1) representative of the telecommunications industry who shall be selected and appointed by the Board of County

Commissioners; one (1) representative from a domestic violence awareness, services, and/or prevention organization who shall be selected and appointed by the Board of County Commissioners; one (1) representative from an elderly awareness, services and/or advocacy organization who shall be selected and appointed by the Board of County Commissioners; one member of the Miami-Dade County Domestic Violence Oversight Board who shall be selected and appointed by the Board of County Commissioners; one (1) representative from a community based organization dedicated to supporting families with at-risk or disabled children who shall be selected and appointed by the Board of County Commissioners; and one (1) representative from a disability awareness, services, and/or advocacy organization who shall be selected and appointed by the County Manager; and one (1) member of the Miami-Dade Enterprise Technology Services Department, or its successor, who shall be selected and appointed by the Director of that Department.

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
