Subject: *Res.* Resolution Authorizing Execution of Amendment to Increase the Current Contract Dollar Amount by \$124,250 for Maintenance and Support Services Provided by NewVision Systems Corporation to Miami-Dade County Office of the Property Appraiser

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached resolution authorizing execution of amendment to increase the current contract dollar amount of \$50,750 by \$124,250 over the remaining (3) years of the contract, between Miami-Dade County Office of the Property Appraiser (PA) and NewVision Systems Corporation (NewVision) for the maintenance and support services of the NewVision software. The increase will bring the total contract amount to \$175,000.

SCOPE

In an effort to improve efficiency of processing deeds to meet PA's roll submission requirements, the PA has identified opportunities to improve the data entry and interface between the NewVision software and the Computer Aided Mass Appraisal System (CAMA).

FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

Funding will be expended from the PA's current budget. No additional funding will be required.

TRACK RECORD/MONITOR

There are no known performance issues with the vendor. The PA will monitor this contract.

BACKGROUND

During the normal course of roll preparation, the PA's CAMA system is periodically shutdown for data entry during key periods to ensure the integrity of the roll. This causes delays in the processing of deeds, which is statutorily required for the valuation of properties during the roll year. The software enhancements will enable the PA's staff to use the NewVision system in an off-line mode during scheduled roll processing shutdown times. As a result of this enhancement, staff will be able to continue processing deeds without having to wait until the system is open for normal business.

Therefore, it is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution authorizing execution of amendment to increase the current contract dollar amount to \$175,000 between the County and NewVision for maintenance services provided to the PA.
