

**Recommendation**

The following plat is hereby submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners for approval. The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval and recording of the plat listed below. This plat is bounded on the north by the MacArthur Causeway Ramp, on the east by Biscayne Bay, on the south by the Turning Basin north of NE 8 Street, and on the west by Biscayne Boulevard.

**Plat Restrictions**


- That individual wells shall not be permitted within this subdivision, except for swimming pools, sprinkler systems and/or air conditioners.

- That all new electric and communication lines, except transmission lines, within this subdivision, shall be installed underground.

RESOLUTION NO. R-195-11

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAT OF MUSEUM PARK, LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 53 SOUTH, RANGE 42 EAST AND SECTION 37, TOWNSHIP 54 SOUTH, RANGE 41 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY THE MACARTHUR CAUSEWAY RAMP, ON THE EAST BY BISCAVNE BAY, ON THE SOUTH BY THE TURNING BASIN NORTH OF NE 8 STREET AND ON THE WEST BY BISCAVNE BOULEVARD)

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, has this day presented to this Board a plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said plat to be known as MUSEUM PARK, the same being a replat of Tract "A" of "New World Center Bicentennial Park", according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 140, at Page 50, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and a subdivision of a portion of the "James Hagan Donation", all lying and being in the Southwest 1/4 of Section 31, Township 53 South, Range 42 East and Section 37, Township 54 South, Range 41 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the plat of MUSEUM PARK on behalf of Miami-Dade County in its capacity as one of the fee simple title holders, that said plat is hereby approved; that the dedication of the streets, alleys and other rights-of-way however designated or depicted on said plat is hereby accepted; that the Miami-Dade County Plat Restrictions as listed on said plat are approved and are to be enforced; that approval of the plat is not a waiver of any zoning

regulations and that the requirements of the zoning existing on this land at the time this resolution is approved shall be enforced whether or not various parcels on this plat conform to those requirements; this approval is conditioned upon the proper execution of all documents required by the County Attorney's Office.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sen Javier D. Souto** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
