At the April 12, 2011 Internal Management and Fiscal Responsibility Committee meeting, the foregoing resolution was amended to remove language authorizing the use of Charter County Transportation Surtax funds, as this contract is only funded with Federal Transit Administration funds.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve award of this contract to Michelin North America, Inc. to provide tire leasing and related services for the Miami-Dade Transit Department. This contract includes Federal Transit Administration provisions.

BACKGROUND

This contract provides for tire leasing and related services for the Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) Department's fleet of revenue buses. The awarded bidder will provide a sufficient supply of new and retreaded tires at all facilities ensuring MDT continuity of service. The tire services include, but are not limited to, mounting/dismounting, wheel rim inspection, tire repairs, re-grooving and re-treading, balancing, disposal of tires, and providing monthly usage and performance data reports to MDT. The awarded bidder will also provide equipment, tools, and materials to perform the services.

A "lease vs. buy" analysis confirmed that buying tires, repair materials, shop equipment, and personnel services would cost the County over \$1 million dollars more than the leasing option over a five year term. Additionally, a recent survey indicated that 25 of 29 major transit agencies in the United States have tire leasing contracts to support their operations.

Buy America provisions are included in FTA funded contracts. One of the tires (size: 285/70R19.5) included in this solicitation did not meet the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) Buy America requirements, and will therefore be presented for award under a separate contract using MDT Operating funds. MDT currently has 75 Opus model buses that were purchased in 2007. This is the only tire that can be used for the Opus model buses manufactured by Optima Bus LLC. Both bidders submitted documentation indicating that this tire is manufactured only in Germany. Market research did not identify any other source for this tire.

RESOLUTION APPROVING AWARD OF CONTRACT NO. 7400: TIRE LEASING AND RELATED SERVICES FOR MIAMI-DADE TRANSIT, TO MICHELIN NORTH AMERICA, INC, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,788,000; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACTS AND TO EXERCISE ANY RENEWAL AND CANCELLATION PROVISIONS CONTAINED THEREIN
