RESOLUTION NO. R-699-11

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO PRESENT A PLAN TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO IMPROVE THE OVERALL MAINTENANCE OF THE GOVERNMENT CENTER COMPLEX AND SURROUNDING FACILITIES, INCLUDING THE STEPHEN P. CLARK CENTER, MAIN PUBLIC LIBRARY, MIAMI ART MUSEUM, AND HISTORICAL MUSEUM OF SOUTHERN FLORIDA AND ADJACENT COURTYARDS, FOUNTAINS AND LANDSCAPING, AND ALL OTHER COUNTY FACILITIES

**WHEREAS**, the Government Center complex, and specifically, the Stephen P. Clark Center, is a visible and important symbol of County government to the masses of County residents, visitors and tourists as it represents the seat of Miami-Dade County government and is County Hall for the millions of residents of Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Government Center complex is also a multi-modal transit hub that serves as a central converging point for residents and tourists visiting the Downtown Miami District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Government Center complex also houses Public Art, fountains and courtyards for the public's enjoyment and benefit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Government Center complex is immediately adjacent to the County facility and main courtyard housing the Main Public Library, the Miami Art Museum and the Historical Museum of Southern Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the Main Public Library, the Miami Art Museum, the Historical Museum of Southern Florida and the main courtyard are visited by County residents and

tourists and dignitaries from all over the world interested in enjoying the arts, culture, and history of our area,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,** that this Board directs the County Mayor or his designee to present a plan to this Board within 30 days to improve the overall maintenance of the Government Center complex, including the Stephen P. Clark Center, the Main Public Library, the Miami Art Museum, the Historical Museum of Southern Florida, and adjacent facilities such as courtyards, fountains and landscaping>>, and all other County facilities<<<sup>1</sup>. The plan should examine capital repairs to these facilities to a level befitting the seat of County government and improve the overall appearance, cleanliness, and security of the exterior envelope, corridors and courtyards.

The prime sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Jose "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Audrey Edmonson** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
