

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE JULY 3, 2011 “MISSION OF HOPE BENEFIT CONCERT” SPONSORED BY MIAMI VINEYARD COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$790.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE UNSPENT BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 11 FY 2008-09 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

**WHEREAS**, Miami Vineyard Community Church, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the July 3, 2011 “Mission of Hope Benefit Concert” in an amount not to exceed \$790.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

**WHEREAS**, the “Mission of Hope Benefit Concert” is a fundraiser to benefit Mission of Hope Haiti which provides assistance to those impacted by the catastrophe in Haiti; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami Vineyard Community Church, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

**WHEREAS**, the “Mission of Hope Benefit Concert” is a small event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$790.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the unspent balance of the District 11 FY 2008-09 In-kind Reserve Fund,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the July 3,



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## **Recommendation**

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends this item move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for funding of this request.

## **Background**

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization, Miami Vineyard Community Church, Inc., for their "Mission of Hope Benefit Concert" event held on July 3, 2011.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$790 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the use of a large stage. This event will be funded from the unspent balance of the District 11 FY 2008-09 in-kind reserve fund.
