


REASON FOR REJECTION

This solicitation would establish a contract for Miami-Dade Police Department (MDPD) to purchase model year 2012 police patrol vehicles. Bids were received from four vendors which offered several different types of police patrol vehicles. The vehicles offered were Chevrolet Impala, Ford Police Interceptor, Chevrolet Caprice, and Dodge Charger PPV.

The method of award was to the three responsive responsible bidders offering the lowest practical life cycle cost for the item. The three lowest priced offers were for Chevrolet Impalas.

During the evaluation process, MDPD did an analysis of the payload capacity and rear passenger leg room. Based on the analysis, MDPD determined that the Chevrolet Impala did not have the payload capacity to safely carry MDPD personnel and equipment for daily operations. Chevrolet Impala had the least rear leg room which would pose a potential safety hazard. Payload and space capacity requirements were not included in the solicitation. MDPD has recommended that the bids be rejected.

A replacement solicitation with revised specifications was advertised on September 2, 2011. The revised specifications include minimum requirements for payload capacity and rear legroom space.


