

RESOLUTION NO. R-1109-11

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 77TH COURT FROM
CORAL WAY TO SW 31ST STREET AS "SANTIAGO
ARANEGUI WAY"

WHEREAS, Santiago Aranegui was born in Havana, Cuba, and from an early age felt the need to find the reason for the connection that unites the mysteries of human existence; and

WHEREAS, Santiago Aranegui at nine years of age was an avid reader of books dealing with mystical, esoteric and philosophical topics joining the Rosicrucian Order at the age of 17; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Aranegui obtained his degree in Social Studies at the University of Havana and shortly after, on September 8th, 1960, emigrated to the United States; and

WHEREAS, after performing a variety of jobs, he started studying architecture and worked in the field in Miami and Puerto Rico; and

WHEREAS, in 1972, he returned to Miami and opened an architecture firm; and in 1974, he became a professor of architecture at Miami-Dade College; and

WHEREAS, in 1984, he founded a Rosicrucian Lodge in Spanish and to this day, along with his wife Marisela Amador, he is committed to organizing conferences and classes of a mystical nature at higher levels and currently has a radio program "Ayer, Hoy y Mañana" (Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow); and

WHEREAS, SW 77th Court from Coral Way to SW 31st Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Santiago Aranegui with this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, finds that Santiago Aranegui has made a direct, significant lifetime contribution to this community.

Section 2. By a three-fifths vote of the Board members present, codesignates SW 77th Court from Coral Way to SW 31st Street as "Santiago Aranegui Way".

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Land Development/Right-of-Way Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Sen Javier D. Souto**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
