



RESOLUTION NO. R-99-12

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HIALEAH
CODESIGNATION OF EAST 7 AVENUE FROM EAST 56
STREET TO EAST 60 STREET AS "DR. ADA HERNANDEZ
WAY"

WHEREAS, on August 9th, 2011, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah adopted Resolution No. 11-75, which designated East 7 Avenue from East 56 Street to East 60 Street as "Dr. Ada Hernandez Way," in recognition of her contributions to the City of Hialeah, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hernandez attained a Bachelor's degree and Master's degree in Early Childhood Education from Florida International University as well as a Specialist and Doctor of Education degree from Nova University with a Major in Early and Middle Childhood Education; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hernandez was certified as a teacher by the State of Florida in 1976, and began her career as an educator with Miami-Dade Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hernandez taught at both M. A. Milam and Ben Sheppard Elementary Schools, and later became an Assistant Principal at Hialeah Elementary and Twin Lakes Elementary; and

WHEREAS, in 1996, Dr. Hernandez became Principal at Amelia Earhart Elementary and under her administration, the school went from a "D" to an "A" and has remained an "A" school ever since; and

WHEREAS, East 7 Avenue from East 56 Street to East 60 Street is a city street located in the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 13,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Hialeah codesignation of East 7 Avenue from East 56 Street to East 60 Street as “Dr. Ada Hernandez Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hialeah, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division and Land Development/Right-of-Way Division of the Miami-Dade Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Hialeah Police Department and the Hialeah Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Esteban L. Bovo, Jr. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE CO-DESIGNATION OF A PORTION OF EAST 7 AVENUE, BETWEEN EAST 56 STREET AND EAST 60 STREET, HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AS "DR. ADA HERNANDEZ WAY", IN HONOR AND RECOGNITION OF HER OUTSTANDING SERVICE AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO EDUCATION AND THE CITY OF HIALEAH AND ITS RESIDENTS, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the co-designation of that portion of East 7 Avenue, between East 56 Street and East 60 Street, as "DR. ADA HERNANDEZ WAY", presently unnamed, is in honor and recognition of the outstanding service and contributions to education of Dr. Ada Hernandez; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hernandez was born in Cuba and immigrated to the United States in 1961; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hernandez attained a Bachelor's degree and Master's degree in Early Childhood Education from Florida International University (F.I.U.), as well as a Specialist and Doctor of Education degree from Nova University with a Major in Early and Middle Childhood Education; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hernandez was certified as a teacher by the State of Florida in 1976, and began her career as an educator with Miami-Dade County Public Schools (MDCPS); and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hernandez has taught at both M.A. Milam and Ben Sheppard Elementary, teaching various grade levels; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hernandez then became Assistant Principal at Hialeah Elementary, and later Twin Lakes Elementary; and

WHEREAS, in 1996, she became the Principal at Amelia Earhart Elementary; and

WHEREAS, under her administration, Amelia Earhart went from a "D" school to an "A" school in 2001, and has remained an "A" school ever since; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hernandez's enthusiastic support and constant motivation of both her teachers and her students has played a critical role in her school's maintenance of its "A" status, as well as the attainment of several awards by its students; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Board recommended approval of this resolution on July 25, 2011.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The portion of East 7 Avenue, between East 56 Street and East 60 Street, Hialeah, Florida, presently unnamed, is hereby co-designated as "DR. ADA HERNANDEZ WAY", and shall be known as such from this day forward, with the costs of signage to be paid by the City.




